November meeting: 7:30 pm, Tuesday, 28 Nov. 1961, downstairs auditorium, Austin Public Library, 9th & Guadalupe Streets. Speaker for the evening is DR. T. R. BUIE of Southwest Texas State Teachers College at San Marcos, Texas. Besides knowing about pioneer trails in the U.S., he has recently been doing research in the Carolina area. We have waited about a year to schedule his program.

We also hope for a report from our Nominating Committee. We may need new Officers & Chairmen & a few new Board members. We hope to hear further about our Constitution & by-laws, also. Now that we have our Charter, we can apply for the postal reductions possible for non-profit organizations.

As of 31 Oct. 1961, our Treasurer reported 205 members on the rolls with 175 paid 1961 dues. Of these, 153 charter members paid; we have 22 new members for 1961. New members since our Sept, 1961 Quarterly are:

We will be interested to see their family data when filed with AGS.

With this quarterly or soon thereafter, pedigree charts should be mailed to all paid 1961 members not having received any. As of now, each 1961 membership (\$3.00 paid) entitles the member to file one 5-generation chart of family data to be published in the Feb, 1962 quarterly. New members will probably start with themselves. Charter members will probably continue their lines from the last chart & file corrections & additions. There is some discussion of using the Memphis Genealogical Society method; their yearbook & index & last 1961 quarterly has just been published, allowing 8 ancestors per member, I believe. It is possible we might have a Board ruling on this next year.

Dues for 1962 are now payable; they fall due 31 Dec. 1961. Our Feb, 1962 quarterlies will not be mailed to unpaid members; the new Constitution sets a deadline for payment also. Dues for all members, residents & non-residents of Austin, remain \$3.00 per year & cover 4 quarterlies, any mailings & hand-outs, and any other benefits during the year.

AGS had a busy 1961. Besides the material run in the quarterlies, we have members working on the 1860 Travis County census, nearing completion, & the 1875 Austin census. The 1867 Voters List of Travis County has been copied & is being indexed. The 1850 Travis Co. Mortality Schedules is copied. We wish to copy the 1841 Registered Voters in Austin & continue the library bibliographies begun. Bible records, small cemeteries & more census are needed. One member suggests we copy the Texas census index cards at Barker & make it more generally available. Someone might extract genealogical data from early Austin newspapers.

Appreciation is due to the Committee members of AGS and our Officers & Chairmen & Board. A year ago, we ended 1960 with speaker Miss Mildred Dulaney, now editor of the TSGS quarterly STIRPES. Other speakers gave us their time & effort in 1961: Mrs. J. F. Kramer, Mr. Robt. H. Folmar & Mrs. Walker in Jan; Mr. McFall Kerbey in Feb; Mr. & Mrs. Garland Barcus in Mar; Mr. William K. Peace in Apr; Mr. & Mrs. Robt. R. Bunten in May; Mrs. Mabel Huckaby & Miss Miriam Dozier in June; an AGS exchange & trade night in July; no meeting in Aug; Mrs. H. H. Rugeley in Sept; and Dr. Ben H. Procter in Oct. With the program of our Dr. T. R. Buie, we will have had a year of activities in genealogy. As a newly organized group, we are fortunate in having managed so much. Let 1962 be as good!

Collins, Jr, Pres. of the Dallas Local History & Genealogy Society, on "Americans of Royal Descent".
