The next meeting is 7:30 pm, Tuesday, 26 May 1962 in the downstairs auditorium of the Austin Public Library, 9th & Guadalupe. We are most fortunate in being able to hear MR. CHESTER V. KIEIMAN, Archivist of the Barker Library at the University of Texas, speaking on THE BARKER LIBRARY AND THE GENEALOGIST. He will give us information that should be helpful to the genealogist who is seeking more data than is available at usual sources.

AGS voted at the May meeting to sponsor the micro-filming of the only known copy of A NARRATIVE OF THE CAPTURE & SUBSEQUENT SUFFERINGS OF THE MIER PRISONERS IN MEXICO, by Thomas W. Bell, one of the captives, R. Morris & Co., DeSoto County, Mississippi, 1845—now owned by the Texas Collection at the University—in order to have a copy made for the Texas Archives.

There are new Texas societies—South Plains Genealogical Society, C/O Public Iibrary, Lubbock, Texas (1st bulletin, Dec, 1961) & Beaumont Gene. & Historical Society, Route 1, Box 128, Vidor, Texas. We sent them our April 1962 issue for "Exchange". NOT ALL EXCHANGES ARE OUT—We'd like more strategic addresses for these states: Ariz, Del, Fla, Ill, Minn, Maine, Nev, N.C., N.Dak, S.Dak, Vt., Wyo., Alaska & Hawaii. Does anyone know of GENEALOGY societies there???

Mrs. Richard P. Woods of Austin has produced a perpetual calendar (1753-2059) on one $8\frac{1}{2}$ x ll page, to be printed in our quarterly or separately. She designed those <u>family records booklets</u> shown by Mrs. R. G. Murrie (Editor, Central Texas Gene. Soc, Waco) at State Conference; her <u>census forms</u> are also used over Texas.

At a spring meeting AGS had samples of U.S. <u>family history maps</u> for tracing your ancestors across the country. Idaho Genealogical Society, Inc., 610 North Julia Davis Drive, Boise, Idaho, sells them at 5¢ each plus postage.

What a spring? Besides informative speeches, our speakers brought us leaflets. Mr. DeWitt C. Nogues gave "Notes on Microfilm & Genealogy" listing available microfilm census schedules & where to find out about ordering or seeing them. Judge Roy C. Archer entertained the audience with a spirited & witty description of genealogical & historical conditions in Travis County. We received "A Travis" County Bibliography" on the Texas State Archives & partial listings of genealogical materials from Texas State Library Loan & General Reference Section. member secured copies of "How To Use The Card Catalog" at U.T. Presidents Barcus provided "How to Trace Your Family Tree" from FAMILY WEEKLY MAGAZINE, 12 Feb 1956. Visitors to the State Conference received a stack of material (including that research pack Dr. Buie worked on). There were about 200 people milling about among the displays & exuding general happiness & enthusiasm. Attendance at AGS has been 60-80 members & visitors a meeting; & we have 29 new members. We're proud too of all that data you filed for publication in our April quarterly; may it bring you much correspondence & data-and don't forget to GIVE. Them that does, GETS!!! Which reminds us -volunteer to our Director of Research now & help copy material. Meanwhile, we should have a successful summer of research. Good Hunting.

The state-wide conference of the Texas State Genealogical Society held in Austin April 29 and 30 was most successful if judged from the many letters which we have received from out-of-town visitors and from the telephone calls and personal contacts we have had.

The reason for this success is very simple. The planning was excellent; every person who had a job to do did it well; and all worked together in complete harmony.

The Austin Genealogical Society has a chance to progress and to become the leader in the field of local and family history in Texas. Many of the members have already filled out one or more of their lines. As time permits, each should work to complete additional lines.

Now that the Genealogical and Reference Room of the State Library is open and parking space is reserved for patrons, we should take advantage of the many reference books that are available. Those interested in Texas genealogy have the opportunity of using the many valuable books and papers which can be found in the State Archives Division.

To those of you who do not know how to start in your search and would like to have some help in learning how to go about it, please contact us or some of the members who work in the libraries. It may be that with a little assistance you can begin a very interesting search for your now unknown ancestors.

There are many people in Austin who are interested in genealogy and who would like to be members. Why not let us know the names of your friends who would like to join the Austin Genealogical Society?

"Ancestors" is a wonderful conversational subject!

THE EPISCOPAL CHURCH IN AUSTIN (From a St. David's Church leaflet of 1956)

"The first Episcopal Church service was held in 1840 by the Rev. Caleb Ives, the Episcopal clergyman & schoolteacher who had established the first Episcopal Church in Texas, in Matagorda during the year 1836.

The foundations of the present Church building were laid in 1853.

All of the early members of the Church were involved with the government and growth of Austin and the State of Texas.

The name of the first Episcopal Church was Christ Church. Later reorganization became necessary and the church was renamed the Church of the Epiphany. It was admitted to the Diocese of Texas in 1852.

During the troubles which later resulted in the Civil War, about 20 of the 'union sympathizers' withdrew from the Church of the Epiphany and formed another congregation, calling themselves Christ Church—April 1856.

As events developed, in 1859, the Rector of the Church of the Epiphany, Rev. Edward Fontaine, resigned & left Texas. The congregation of Christ Church had a rector, Rev. Charles Gillette, but no church building. The two congregations merged on July 19, 1859, elected the Rev. Charles Gillette as rector & chose the name St. David, this being the name of the first & only parish served by the newly elected Bishop of Texas, Right Rev. Alexander Gregg, in Cheraw, South Carolina."

In the Nov., 1961, AGS quarterly, in records of St. David's Episcopal Church of Austin, you will find listed the Rev. J. W. TAYS (pp. 93 & 97) and his burial of soldier Moses LeROY, 24 July 1870. The burial of Clement DeLancy Tays (5 yrs, 1 mo) is shown for 14 June 1870 (p. 99) by the Rev. Swancoat.

We understand that the Rev. Joseph Wilkins Tays was born in Nova Scotia of English parents. He graduated from Kings College, Halifax, N.S. and became an Episcopal minister. He was chaplain of the Texas Legislature before moving to El Paso and founded the first Episcopal church, St. Clement's, in El Paso, Texas. Tays Street there was named for him. He died in El Paso or in California.

One son was Eugene Tays, a civil engineer in Texas & Mexico. Eugene had a daughter Linda, apparently, and a son Clement I (died as a boy) & Clement II (died aged 29). There were others of the family in Texas. Mrs. Eugene Tays is said to have lived to be 97 years of age.

ALEXANDER GREGG, FIRST BISHOP OF TEXAS

According to a pamphlet by Arthur Ben Chitty & a biography of Bishop Gregg by his son Wilson Gregg, the GREGG family immigrated from the north of Scotland to Londonderry, Ireland in the time of Cromwell. (They may once have been of the McGregors). Early in the 18th century, David, Andrew & John Gregg moved from Londonderry with families to Mass., Pa., and S.C. John asked for land in S.C. in July, 1752, & received 1300 acres in Cheraw precinct for his wife, one Dutch servant & 5 Negroes.

John's eldest child, Capt. James Gregg of the Revolution (born in S.C.) married Mary WIISON & had 6 children. The sixth child of James was David of Society Hill, S.C. who married Athalinda BROCKY & had a plantation in Darlington County. A Baptist, he was the father of 3 daughters & Alexander Gregg, born 8 Oct. 1819.

Alexander went in 1832/33 to Winnsboro, S.C. academy & at 16, to S.C. College at Columbia (later called the University of S.C.). He graduated 3 Dec 1838 (aged 19) with the highest honors of his class. He was over 6 feet, a good swimmer, a fine horseman, with grey eyes in a handsome, strong face.

On 21 April 1841, he married Charlotte Wilson KOLLOCK, daughter of Oliver Hawes Kellock of Marlboro Co, S.C., a native of Mass. & graduate of Brown University of R.I., an Episcopalian, who had married a niece of Gov. Wilson of S.C. Of 9 children born in S.C., Alexander lost 3; one infant died in Texas where he was born, about 1861/62. The first-born, Alexander, died of pneumonia in service in Richmond, Va. in 1861/62. The eldest of 2 surviving daughters married Mr. Robert COCHRAN of Virginia, who died of cholera on the marriage day. She died a widow in 1895. A second daughter grew up & married & died a widow in 1909. Wilson Gregg of Texas died in 1899. The youngest son, Dr. C. K. Gregg, surgeon, lived in McKinney, Texas, after his service in the West and died there Oct, 1888. The old father, David Gregg of S.C., died there in Oct, 1855. Alexander's wife, Mrs. Charlotte Gregg, died 20 May 1880 & was taken to S.C. to be buried in the old graveyard at St. David's Church in Cheraw.

Bishop Gregg became an Episcopalian minister after his marriage. His first & only parish was St. David's in Cheraw where he was baptized by Rev. J. W. Miles in 1843 & confirmed the same year. He served as rector there for 13 years. He was elected Bishop of Texas at the convention in Austin in May, 1859, and thereafter made a home in Austin or San Antonio for the rest of his life, arriving in Galveston, 8 Dec. 1859. His summer home was in Sewanee, Tenn. after 1869. In Jan, 1892, he retired from active duties as Bishop. In May, 1892, Rev. George Herbert KINSOLVING, D.D., Rector of the Church of the Epiphany, Philadelphia, was elected Bishop & took office. The Rev. Alexander died 10 July 1893. His funeral was held at St. David's in Austin, 12 July 1893 by Bishop Kinsolving and the Rev. T. B. Lee, Rector of St. David's, and others. Bishop Gregg was buried at the old St. David's Church in Cheraw, S.C.

SINKULER, Mgr, 114 Plainfield, Clarendon Hills, Illinois, compiles addresses on any "infrequent" name from 800 telephone directories (1961-62) covering parts of every state, for \$10.00; they can check any 2 spellings of the "same Surname" for \$10.00 or any 3 spellings for \$15.00—only names & addresses (no phone numbers). Takes about 3 weeks.

Chedwato began a new venture in 1962. ANCESTRAL NOTES added 72 additional pages a year—vital records, church, probate, land, pension & Bible records, etc, and queries & answers. This costs \$3.00 per year for the 6 issues. Beginning in Aug, 1962, they are offering MISSING LINKS, the magazine of genealogical clues, 20 pages an issue, 12 times a year. This costs \$3.00 per year for the 12 issues of family genealogical data; only enough for subscribers will be printed. You can apparently order either or both magazines from Chedwato Service, P. O.
