A.G.S. is a non-profit organization chartered by the State of Texas & dedicated to creating and maintaining a society for the study of genealogical history and records & depositing & preserving such records in libraries & archives for the benefit of historians & genealogists. Meetings are scheduled for the fourth Tuesday of each month or as set by the Board of Directors.

The Sept. meeting is at 7:30 pm, Tuesday, 25 Sept 1962 in the downstairs auditorium of the Austin Public Library, 9th & Guadalupe. Our speaker will be new AGS President Lewis H. Carstarphen, discussing the origins of East Texas people. We must also elect from the floor three new members of the Nominating Committee. These will work with one member appointed by the President and one member chosen by the Board to choose the names of 20 new Board nominees for the terms beginning 1 January 1963.

Included in this issue is a copy of your AGS Charter & Constitution & by-laws. These should make clear our precedure for elections, etc. and the duties of the various officers and committees. Of course, as a hobby group, we often tend to be impatient with details of organization. We like to work on genealogy and not politics and committee work. But the present form of AGS government should be useful in allowing most members to concentrate on genealogy.

President Carstarphen is announcing the appointment of Mr. Seth D. Breeding as new chairman of the Membership Committee.

In the heat of August & September, your AGS Executive Committee, your Board and your quarterly Staff met. This starts our fall season energetically. It was decided that we do want to print queries in our magazine; remaining problems are length, form and whether paid or non-paid. Those queries on file, since they are brief, will be printed first when this section is begun.

The state organization TSGS has announced its annual meeting, November 23-24, 1962, at the Baker Hotel, Dallas. The banquet on Friday, 23rd, honors our Dr. Dorman H. Winfrey; speaker for this occasion is James M. Day, State Archivist. There are exhibits and 3 workshops on Saturday, 24th. Mrs. Abby Moran will direct a workshop on "Indexing & Cross-Indexing for Genealogical Purposes." And Mrs. Walter J. Achning (with Mrs. C. D. Leon, Mrs. Walter Burress, Miss Mildred Dulaney & Mrs. Ralph A. Bickler) will direct the workshop on "Programs for Genealogical Societies." The third workshop, directed by Mrs. Charles L. Sarrazin, will be "Proving A Southern Pedigree." Tickets for both days' activities total \$10.25. Advance registration can be made with Mrs. Opal Bricker, 5807 Vanderbilt, Dallas 6, Texas--Telephone TAylor 6-4052.

As many of you are aware, AGS lost one of its finest genealogists this summer with the death of Mrs. Paralee Parrish of Austin. Besides her many other activities, she was most active in the DAR and in copying records and tracing lines for AGS and individuals. Before her death, she gave AGS all wills she and her friend Mrs. G. A. Welsch had abstracted, for Travis County. Mrs. Welsch plans to continue this work with help. Mrs. Parrish provided that her collection be preserved for the use of other researchers. In this connection—remember to put something in your own wills concerning your genealogical collections.

Our New AGS President, Mr. Carstarphen, is so involved in seeing to meeting notices, preparing his speech, holding & attending committee & Board meetings (not to mention living in this world outside of AGS), that he cannot be expected to write us a letter this time. We have had a fine record in programs & activities under the leadership of our friends, former Co-presidents Mr. & Mrs. Garland Barcus, this year; we will miss them while they are in Pakistan. Membership & attendance rose again, and many of the problems of a newly organized group were solved under the Barcuses' direction. Judging by the recent activities of our new President Carstarphen, we seem to have yet another worker leading AGS. But he is going to need your help. If you rush in and work now when we all need you, think of all the resting on your laurels you can do later on!

Exchange editor Mrs. Pettibon is trying to track down all the quarterlies mailed to AGS this year. Some go to various addresses. Mrs. Pettibon maintains a list of all quarterlies (for exchanges) as they come in in order to send back a copy of our quarterly in exchange. Unless she knows what has come in, AGS might be losing valuable chances to exchange. We have been compiling a complete list of all we have and hope to be able to turn it over to a Librarian this year (Note the by-laws of AGS). Newest exchanges were from Fort Worth, TSGS, Waco, Abilene, Oklahoma, Kansas, Louisiana, West Virginia, Connecticut, Indiana & Rhode Island. All copies for Exchange with AGS should be mailed to AGS at 2312 Enfield Road, Austin 3, Texas. Do not send them to the Editor or other officers, at present.

Oklahoma Genealogical Society is having a Conference on Genealogy at the new Okla. Center for Continuing Education at the University of Oklahoma in Norman, Oklahoma --dates: Oct. 12-13. Mrs. Abby Moran, head of SW History & Genealogy Dept. at Ft Worth Public Library will speak Friday morning, Oct. 12, on "A Librarian Looks at Genealogy." AGS has received details on tickets & programs.

We understand that the patron of genealogy at Dallas Public Library, Mrs. Margaret Pratt, retired this summer. She was most active in building the genealogy section there & in organizing genealogy classes in Dallas schools. A memorial fund has been set up, but we don't have details at this time.

Abilene has mailed out her EARLY CEMETERY RECORDS, prepared by West Texas Genealogical Society. This covers Taylor County cemetery records for 1882-1960 in Abilene City Cemetery, the Masonic Cemetery, the IOOF Cemetery (Book I, 159 pp) and Cedar Hill Cemetery (Book II, 96 pp). It covers cemetery lot deeds, burial records, tombstone inscriptions & anything else (obituaries, etc) they could find to check to make the records as complete & correct as possible.

The Spring, 1962 & Summer, 1962 issues of the GENEALOGICAL NEWSLETTER contain, by States, names of hundreds of "Newly-Published County Histories". There are 83 listed for Texas.

The San Bernardino Valley, California, Genealogical Society, a newly organized group, plans 4 issues a year called the Quarterly, with one issue extra to carry names of members & their ancestors. Texas State Archives has been collecting their microfilms all together; we saw a large collection in the reading room corner recently. New card files were put in also. When all the cataloguing is done & all books unpacked, the Archives & State Libary will be something wonderful. Charter of Incorporation

We, the undersigned natural persons, of the age of 21 years or more, all of whom are citizens of Texas, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the laws of Texas, Non Profit Act, do hereby adopt the following articles of incorporation.

- Article I The name of the corporation is Austin Genealogical Society.
- Article II The corporation is a Non Profit Corporation.
- Article III The period of its duration is Fifty Years.
- Article IV The purposes for which this corporation is organized are:
 dedicated to collecting, exchanging, publishing genealogical material for the benefit of historians and genealogists.
- Article V The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 1502 Lorrain Street, Austin, Texas, and the name of the initial registered agent at such address is Jno. A. Gracy.

ARTICLE I NAME AND OBJECT

Section 1. The Society shall be called "The Austin Genealogical Society." Section 2. The object of the Society shall be that of creating and maintaining an organization and a society for the study and investigation of genealogical history and genealogical records, and for the further purpose of receiving and collecting genealogical and historical records and depositing and preserving such records in libraries and archives.

ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP, VOTING, AND DUES

Section 1. Eligibility for Membership: Any person who is interested in the aims and purposes of this Society, and is acceptable to the membership upon the approval of the membership committee, may be admitted.

Section 2. Voting: Each member in good standing is entitled to one (1) vote.

Section 3. Dues: Dues for the members of this Society shall be determined by the Board of Directors not later than December 31 each year for the following calendar year. Dues are payable in advance for the calendar year beginning January 1st. Members who fail to pay current year dues by March 1st will be dropped from the membership roll.

ARTICLE III OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES

Section 1. The governing body of this Society shall be a Board of Directors, composed of twenty (20) members to be nominated at the October meeting, and elected at the November meeting of the Society. Their term of office shall be two (2) years, beginning the January 1st following election. The term of ten (10) members of the Board of Directors shall expire each year, and will be replaced by ten (10) members elected or re-elected to serve two years. The names of ten (10) members selected by the Nominating Committee for the Board of Directors shall be submitted to the Society at the October meeting each year to serve as Directors for two (2) years beginning the following January 1, but nominations may also be made from the floor before the names are voted on.

Section 2. From their number the Board of Directors shall elect a President, lst Vice President, 2nd Vice President, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, and Treasurer. The Board of Directors also shall elect a Librarian, Director of Research, and Editor of the Quarterly who may or may not be members of the Board. The nine officers listed above in this Section, together with the chairmen of the standing committees, shall form the Executive Committee. All officers of the Society shall be elected annually between the November meeting and the following December 31 for a term of one year and installed at the meeting in January following the annual report of the officers for the preceeding year, and will be eligible to succeed themselves if re-elected.

Section 3. The President shall appoint a Parliamentarian.

Section 4. The Board of Directors shall meet quarterly. The Executive Committee shall meet monthly at least one (1) week prior to the regular monthly meeting of the Society, and shall be responsible for the conduct of the Society's business between meetings of the Board of Directors.

Section 5. The Society shall have the following standing committees appointed by the President: Education and Publicity, Membership, Finance, and Program.

Section 6. The President shall appoint an Auditing Committee and a Telephone Committee and may appoint special committees as needed.

ARTICLE III OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES

Section 7. At the September meeting of each year, a Nominating Committee shall be selected in the following manner, one member elected by the Board of Directors, one member appointed by the President, and three members elected by the membership. This committee shall recommend to the Society at the October meeting each year, the ten (10) nominees for the Board of Directors to be elected at the November meeting.

Section 8. Any vacancies occurring between elections shall be filled by the Executive Committee, said appointees to serve until the next regular election.

ARTICLE IV MEETINGS

Section 1. Regular meetings of the Society shall be held on such dates and at such time and place as determined by the Board of Directors.

Section 2. Special meetings may be called by the President.

Section 3. The January meeting shall be the annual meeting.

Section 4. The members present at any meeting of the Society shall constitute a quorum, providing all members have been duly notified of said meeting.

Section 5. Any member of the Society at a meeting of the Society, Executive Committee, or Board of Directors, desiring to address the presiding officer or speaker at such meeting or a member of the Society, shall rise from his or her seat and give his or her name and make the statement or propound the question and remain standing until the person addressed gives the answer.

Section 6. Robert's Rules of Order, Revised, shall control as to any matters not provided for in these By-laws.

ARTICLE V DUTIES OF OFFICERS

Section 1. The officers shall perform the duties prescribed by these By-laws. Section 2. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Society and of the Executive Committee and Board of Directors. He, or she, shall be the chief executive officer of the Society. He, or she, shall appoint all committees, except the Nominating Committee, and shall be ex-officio member of all committees except the Nominating Committee.

Section 3. The 1st Vice President shall, in the absence of the President, perform the duties pertaining to that office. If both are absent, then the 2nd Vice President shall preside.

Section 4. The Recording Secretary shall keep a record of the proceedings of the meetings of the Society and of the Executive Board; shall notify officers of their election and the committees of their appointment; shall keep a roll of the members of the Society, and have the custody of all papers of the Society not otherwise provided for, which papers and records shall be open for inspection at any time, in the presence of the Secretary, by any member of the Society. In the absence of the President and Vice Presidents, the Secretary shall call the meeting to order and preside until a chairman pro tem is elected. At the expiration of the Secretary's term of office, the records and all papers in her possession shall be turned over to a successor.

NOTE: According to Charter of Incorporation issued by the State of Texas: John A. Gracy is the registered Agent of The Society and his Registered Office is 1502 Lorrain Street, of Austin, Texas; and, further, this can be changed at any time by amendment to the Charter. (See March & April '62 Minutes).

ARTICLE V DUTIES OF OFFICERS

Section 5. The Corresponding Secretary shall conduct such correspondence as may be requested by the President of the Society or the Executive Committee, and have custody of all letters. It shall be the duty of the Corresponding Secretary to give notice of all meetings in co-operation with the Telephone Committee.

Section 6. The Treasurer shall receive all funds of the Society and shall deposit them in such bank or banks as may be designated by the Board of Directors. The Treasurer shall disburse these funds, as directed by the Society, provided that no bill over ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be paid without the written authorization of the President. The Treasurer shall present a report at each regular meeting and an annual report at each annual meeting in January. Previous to each annual meeting, the Treasurer's accounts shall be audited by an Auditing Committee.

Section 7. The Librarian shall be in charge of such records or books as may be accumulated by the Society, and see that they are placed in such libraries as may be acceptable to the Board of Directors, or placed where they will be readily accessible for reference.

Section 8. The Director of Research shall aid in research at the request of the members.*

Section 9. The Editor of the Quarterly shall issue the quarterly at the accepted time each quarter.

Section 10. The Parliamentarian, if convenient, shall be present at each meeting of the Society, of the Executive Committee, and of the Directors and answer any questions regarding parliamentary procedure.

ARTICLE VI AMENDMENTS

These By-laws may be amended at any regular meeting by a majority vote of the members present, provided the amendment has been presented in writing at the previous regular meeting or due notice of the proposed change given to members in writing at least ten (10) days prior to the date of the regular meeting at which the amendment is to be voted on.

Resolution presented with above, 27 Feb 1962:

Resolved, that the proposed By-laws submitted by the Committee to Consider the Revision of the By-laws, be adopted as the By-laws of The Austin Genealogical Society to become effective immediately except (1) that the present Officers and Directors shall continue to serve until December 31, 1962 and (2) that twenty directors shall be elected for the year 1963, ten for a term of one year and ten for a term of two years, the nomination and election of such directors except for number and term of office to be in accordance with the By-laws.

* The Director of Research coordinates AGS research; she does not trace lines. ** The Official copy is in AGS minutes of the meeting of 27 March 1962.

Membership as recorded in the Minister's & Church Register of the Webberville Society, Webberville Circuit, Texas Conference, Methodist Episcopal Church, South. The First Roll was made in 1883 & lasts till 1884 (noted with *); the Final Roll was made up in 1924. The Church ceased to exist about 1925 (members marked **); at this time the Register passed into possession of Banks McLaurin. Information was catalogued & prepared for publication by Banks McLaurin, Jr, 5843 Royal Crest, Dallas 30, Texas, a native of Austin whose mother still lives here. Banks, Jr. has records on all these church members with names HAMILTON, McLAURIN, SMITH, BENNETT, BAKER, HALL, POPE, HAYS, McCOLL, McEACHERN & MORRIS, and some information on others. His articles on the BANKS Family & the OSBORN Family have been published by the quarterly of the Local History & Genealogical Society, Dallas, Texas--where you may find further data.

Included with this issue of the quarterly is to be an $8\frac{1}{2}$ x 11 perpetual calendar prepared by AGS member Mrs. Richard P. Woods. This is a convenient size to carry in notebooks or folders & covers most of the period for which we need to know the days & dates. Mrs. Woods came to us from Waco Society & is active on your Staff. She is now making herself a looseleaf scrapbook of clippings of Col. Pearson's genealogy column "Your Brand & Mine" from the Austin TIMES-HERALD. Paste & glue wrinkle newsprint, so she uses a 35ϕ bottle of Carter's Clean Grip Rubber Cement. A larger bottle dries out if not used up. Any misplaced cement can be rolled & rubbed off. She says it is better to place one column per page (using only one side of the notebook pages) so as to be able to insert pages chronologically if missed & to use looseleaf pages also so as to remove them for reproduction. She prefers staple-shaped to ring fasteners since pages lie flat & don't slip down & wrinkle in the closed notebook.
