President's Letter

Those who are sincerely interested in ancestor hunting are usually the kind of people who will go out of their way to help almost anyone -- and this has never been better demonstrated than in the past year by members of the Austin Genealogical Society.

During the summer I had the opportunity to talk with Mrs. O. W. Senglaub, president of Milwaukee County Genealogical Society, Mrs. Darice W. Lord, professional genealogist, Mr. & Mrs. W. L. Van Brocklin, editors of the State Society of Wisconsin news letter, and others in that area. I attended a meeting of the Genealogical Society at Whitnall Park, where they have planted and care for an ancestral grove of trees, dedicated to pioneers and veterans. I spent considerable time "selling" the idea that genealogy is of interest to many people; and I had the pleasure of speaking on radio twice in August, and writing a series of articles on "How To Trace Your Ancestors" for the Milwaukee Journal. I found, also, that a course in genealogy is taught at night in the Shorewood Opportunity School for adults; and Mr. Otis F. Swiger, the teacher, uses an approach similar to that used here in getting high school students interested in genealogy.

We now have an arrangement with Western Publications here in Austin ("True West", and "Pioneer West"), whereby a letter is sent to those who have sent in genealogical questions, stating that the letter has been referred to AGS. We are assisting each other, and gaining considerable publicity. I hope shortly to have a similar arrangement with Mr. Horace Powell of Milwaukee, who publishes the only Welsh paper in the United States; he frequently receives letters requiring genealogical assistance.

Officers of Austin Genealogical Society took action, during my absence this summer, in getting plans under way for the State meeting 26-27 November here in Austin. It is wonderful to have people take the initiative when action is necessary, and to have others accept assignments as chairmen for various activities. This confirms my earlier statement about genealogists. A slogan for AGS and similar societies might well be, "Opportunities unlimited -- for solving problems, meeting new people, and assisting old friends, for a greater enjoyment of life."

Please give the location of the cemetery, including highway and road directions to reach it, and comment on its general condition. Mr. E. A. KING is Chairman of the Cemetery Records Committee, and can tell you whether a cemetery has been copied or not. He maintains maps of Travis and surrounding counties, and will be glad to give you directions to reach a cemetery which needs copying. Deadline for records for this issue will be 1 Nov.

As of the date of publication of the Summer Quarterly, more than 100 Family Data Sheets have been received; and 3" x 5" index cards have already been typed on them and filed for next Spring's Quarterly. Better hurry in with your Data Sheets before it gets too full!

1966 Summer Quarterly

Family Bible Records will again be featured in the Summer Quarterly in 1966, just as this year. Please keep this in mind when you visit relatives between now and 30 June 1966, the deadline for material for this issue. The best copies are, of course, photostats or xerox or similar processes; however, a typewritten copy or, in a pinch, a handwritten copy, is a lot better than none. In many instances, the old Bibles have been lost or burned, but some thoughtful member of the family has made a copy of the births, deaths and marriages from it before it is gone. When publishing these Family Bible Records, it is most desirable to give the name and principal residences of the original owner who made most of the entries, the name and address of the person who now has the Bible, and your name. It is very important to record the data from that old Family Bible this year; because it might be lost, burned or discarded by this time next year. One of our members found several quite old Family Bibles in a second-hand book store on Red River Street in Austin several years ago. A local house wrecker states that he sometimes finds Family Bibles in his work.

1966 Spring Quarterly Ancestor Registry

Many members found it difficult this year to prepare their Family Data Sheets in time to get their data published in the Spring Quarterly. These instructions, and the copy of the Data Sheet on the other side of this sheet, are presented in an effort to assist these members in getting their material prepared in time for the 1966 Spring issue. This Data Sheet can be copied on any typewriter or copier; and the printed forms can be purchased through the Treasurer, the Secretary or the Editor.

Each member may submit as many as 20 new Data Sheets for the 1966 Spring Quarterly; these should include information on 40 individuals (husbands and wives). As in the 1964 and 1965 Spring quarterlies, the 1966 Ancestor Registry will index all ancestors and ancestresses by SURNAME.

Corrected Data Sheets on individuals who have appeared in earlier issues of the Spring Quarterly will not count in the 20 new Data Sheets for the 1966 issue. You should prepare new Data Sheets on any individuals on whom you have obtained new or corrected information since publication of their data in the earlier Spring Quarterly.

Deadline for receipt by the Editor of Data Sheets for inclusion in the 1966 Spring Quarterly is 15 February 1966; therefore you have plenty of time to prepare the Data Sheets and get them to the Editor before that time. The editorial staff must type the information on each Data Sheet onto 3" x 5" index cards; and the earlier you can send in your Data Sheets, the sooner the index cards can be typed up. This will eliminate the last minute rush evident the last two years; and the editorial staff will be most grateful for the additional time. Your Data Sheets will be returned to you.

Special Instructions:

1. Please type or print all entries on the Data Sheets. Handwriting is sometimes difficult to read; and this leads to unnecessary errors in the Quarterly.
2. All SURNAMES are to be in all capital letters; each Given Name has only the initial letter in capital, with the other letters in lower case.
3. Use Maiden SURNAME for a woman, not her husband's SURNAME.
4. Each date, (when), should be as complete as possible, with day given first, month spelled out, and year. (Example: 20 September 1965).
5. Each place, (where), should be as complete as possible, and should include township, county or parish, if possible.
6. Children's names should be as complete as possible, and listed in order of birth; continue on back of Data Sheet if you run out of room on the front.
7. Please underline the name of the child in your lineage.
8. Any additional data or explanation you wish to add for clarification should be placed on the back of the Data Sheet.
9. Make a separate Data Sheet for each marriage of the ancestor on this page, and enter in short blank following the word, "married", whether the marriage on this page was his 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or which, only if he was married more than once.
10. Make a separate Data Sheet for each marriage of the ancestress on this page, if she was married more than once.

This is an excellent opportunity for you to publish your lineages, to help out others who are collateral kinsmen, and to bring to the attention of thousands of genealogists all over the country the lines on which your information is incomplete. Each year that our Ancestor Registry is published makes our Quarterly a better reference.
