One of the best things -- the most rewarding -- about this work in which we are all interested -- is getting to know people like we found in Austin this past weekend!" This letter was received after a wonderful meeting of the State society here in Austin, 26-27 November, which was a success in every respect. Mrs. DECKLER and her associates gave us a wonderful program. Local members serving as chairmen and workers did a fine job. The Austin Chamber of Commerce furnished assistance. Mr. and Mrs. James T. We have received more than 200 Family Data Sheets; and 3" x 5" index cards have already been typed on them. Better hurry in with your Data Sheets before it gets too full! Deadline for receipt of Family Data Sheets for this issue will be 15 February 1966.

1966 Summer Quarterly

Family Bible Records will again be featured in the Summer Quarterly in 1966, just as this year. Please keep this in mind when you visit relatives between now and the end of June. The best copies are, of course, photostats or xerox or other photocopies; however, a typewritten copy or, in a pinch, a handwritten copy, are better than none. Please give the name and principal residences of the original owner who made most of the entries, the name and address of the person who now has the Bible, and your name. It is very important to record the data from that old Family Bible this year, because it might be lost, burned or discarded by this time next year.

1966 Fall Quarterly

Cemetery records will be featured in the Fall Quarterly in 1966, as in previous years. During the winter and spring, before the brush puts out its leaves and the weeds get high, is the time to copy the inscriptions in that old cemetery you've been meaning to do. Please give the location of the cemetery, including highway and road directions to reach it and comment on its general condition. The Chairman of the Cemetery Records Committee maintains maps of Travis and surrounding counties, and can tell you whether a cemetery has been copied or not. If you want to copy a cemetery, the Chairman will be glad to give you directions and instructions.

1966 Spring Quarterly Ancestor Registry

Many members found it difficult this year to prepare their Family Data Sheets in time to get their data published in the Spring Quarterly. These instructions, and the copy of the Data Sheet on the other side of this sheet, are presented in an effort to assist these members in getting their material prepared in time for the 1966 Spring issue. The Data Sheet can be copied on any typewriter or copier; or the printed forms can be purchased from the Treasurer, the Secretary or the Ancestor Records Committee.

Each member may submit as many as 20 new Data Sheets for the 1966 Spring Quarterly; these should include information on 40 individuals (husbands and wives). As in the 1964 and 1965 Spring quarterlies, the 1966 Ancestor Registry will index all ancestors and ancestresses by SURNAME.

Corrected Data Sheets on individuals who have appeared in earlier issues of the Spring Quarterly will not count in the 20 new Data Sheets for the 1966 issue. You should prepare new Data Sheets on any individuals on whom you have obtained new or corrected information since publication of their data in the earlier Spring Quarterly.

Deadline for receipt of Data Sheets for inclusion in the 1966 Spring Quarterly is 15 February 1966; therefore you have plenty of time to prepare the Data Sheets and get them in before that time. The editorial staff must type the information on each Data Sheet onto 3" x 5" index cards; and the earlier you can send in your Data Sheets, the sooner the index cards can be typed up. This will eliminate the last minute rush evident the last two years; and the editorial staff will be most grateful for the additional time. Your Data Sheets will be returned to you.

Special Instructions:

1. Please type or print all entries on the Data Sheets. Handwriting is sometimes difficult to read; and this leads to unnecessary errors in the Quarterly.
2. All SURNAMES are to be in all capital letters; each Given Name has only the initial letter in capital, with the other letters in lower case.
3. Use Maiden SURNAME for a woman, not her husband's SURNAME.
4. Each date, (when), should be as complete as possible, with day given first, month spelled out, and year. (Example: 20 December 1966).
5. Each place, (where), should be as complete as possible, and should include township, county or parish, if available.
6. Children's names should be as complete as possible, and listed in order of birth; continue on back of Data Sheet if you run out of room on the front.
7. Please underline the name of the child in your lineage.
8. Any additional data or explanation you may wish to add for clarification should be placed on the back of the Data Sheet.
9. When you have ancestors or ancestresses with identical names, use numerical identifiers to distinguish between them. Thus, if John SMITH has a son, John, designate the father as John SMITH (1), and the son as John SMITH (2). These identifying numerals are flexible, and can be changed as you discover additional John SMITHs, or eliminated if you discover identifying second names or initials.

This is an excellent opportunity for you to publish your lineages, to help out others who are collateral kinsmen, and to bring to the attention of thousands of genealogists all over the country the lines on which your information is incomplete. Each year that our Ancestor Registry is published makes our Quarterly a better reference.
