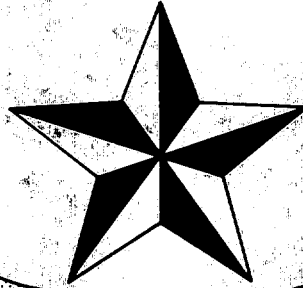

President's Letter

The importance of cooperation in genealogy cannot be stressed too greatly! We are reminded again of this each time a new genealogical book is published containing data on families in which we are interested. In practically every instance most workers on these families know of some additional information that would complete or clear up portions of the new book.

There are several reasons for this lack of cooperation. The first is, of course, procrastination --- just putting off sending the information to the person who is compiling the book. The second is ignorance of the fact that the new book is being compiled --- and the only way that this can be helped is for the compiler to inform all interested workers. The third reason is, I regret, selfishness --- we all consider ourselves budding authors and incipient publishers; so we hold back our precious data to be used in our own book. Then we get hit by a train or an automobile; and the persons cleaning up our effects see no value in all those old papers which they throw away --- and there goes a lifetime of work and a treasury of genealogical data that cannot be duplicated. Finally, out of a mistaken sense of protectiveness, we withhold information that would prove that great-grandpa really did marry a third time after he was sixty, and that he and his third wife had two late children; or we hide the fact that great-uncle Joe was convicted of fence-cutting in the range wars, and died of a neck ailment.

We appeal to you to make your information available to the family researchers who are actively putting together materials for publication. The purpose of genealogy is to record the facts --- all of them! And who knows --- some of the information you have been hoarding just might be in error; and the grateful recipient of your material might be able to straighten up your records of the family and fill in the material that you haven't been able to locate. And --- you will get your name in print in the acknowledgements!

Re: Asa MITCHELL Bible Register - as published in our Summer Quarterly, 1967, taken from the University of Texas archives collection... Eber Cockely, Historical and Genealogical Society, Box 533, Somerset, Pa., 15501 wrote: "Natives of Somerset County have an old by-word, MITCHELLS are known here as Frosty Sons of Thunder. This is the roof garden of Pennsylvania. Tradition is that there is one month of summer (August) and eleven months winter. Enclosed is a sketch of ancestors of Asa MITCHELL in Ireland and Somerset, Pa., also of James MITCHELL, b. 1719 in Ireland."

"TALK OF TEXAS"

HISTORY'S FORGOTTEN MAN---John Charles Beales is a name unfamiliar to historians. But Beales, who was born in England and became a naturalized Mexican, died claiming that he was Texas' biggest landowner.

Between 1832 and 1835, Beales actually controlled 70 million acres of land between the Rio Grande and the Nueces Rivers. Of these, 45 million acres were granted to his Mexican wife by the government of Mexico. Beales acquired the rest through impresario contracts with that country, then set about trying to colonize his new empire. He did bring in two groups of colonists, but bad crops, marauding Indians and Santa Anna's invading armies caused the project to fail.

After Texas became a Republic, Beales was never able to establish claim to the land. He died in New York in 1878.

INSECT TOWN---Bug Tussle, in Fannin County, got its name because two early settlers couldn't agree on what to call the community. They were arguing heatedly about the matter one day when their attention was distracted by a couple of tumbling bugs.

"Look at those bugs tussle," one remarked---and the town was named.

ODD TEXAS---The Jefferson Jimplecute (which is still published) was one of the most famous early Texas newspapers. Legend has it that the editor named it by scattering type on the floor and then picking up the letters at random.

FEARLESS FOLK---Descendants of Briton Bailey can take pride in the fact that their ancestor was one Texan who never looked up to any man.

Bailey settled in the Brazos River bottoms even before Stephen F. Austin brought his colony to Texas, and was among those whom Austin sought to evict as an undesirable character. Later, however, the two made their peace and Brit became a captain in the Texas militia. He built the first brick residence in Austin's colony, and the land he owned in Brazoria County is still known to old-timers as Bailey's Prairie.

In 1883, Bailey fell sick. His death-bed wish was to be buried standing up "with my face to the setting sun" so that the world will say, "There stands Brit Bailey."

Even in death, Brit Bailey refused to bend his head to any man.

LEGEND OF LOVE---One of the famous old Texas cattle brands is the LIL, and its origin is a love story with an ironic twist.

In pioneer days, as the story goes, Miss Lillybelle Plunkett came to Texas with her father who set up a store in the ranch region. From the first, Miss Lillybelle had plenty of suitors but there was no place where courting cowboys could buy the candy, flowers or perfume so important to winning the hand of a lady from the East. So they began catching maverick calves and presenting them to her branded LIL. She encouraged the suitors, accepted the calves but remained single.

Sometime later, she wrote her old sweetheart back East, invited him to come to Texas and they were married. Her herd of LIL cows were the beginning of a very profitable herd.

REPORT OF CEMETERY COMMITTEE

1. Many of the cemeteries in Travis County and adjoining counties have have not been copied as yet. We are limiting most of our work to Travis, Williamson, Burnet, Blanco, Hays, Caldwell and Bastrop, except in certain instances.

Records incomplete but available from Committee, on the following cemeteries for future publication: Whiterock, located west of Austin on Hiway 71, near Bee Caves, Texas; I.O.O.F. Cemetery, Georgetown; Andice, Presbyterian and Old Roundrock, Rhodes, Williamson County.

Additions to Fiskville, Jollyville, Davis, Merrilatown, Pond Springs and others, copied by Mrs. Charles Walker.

2. Records are being read and copied for future publication on "Cemeteries that were removed for the building of Buchanan Dam, Marshall Ford Dam, and other projects by the L.C.R.A. To date old cemeteries listed are: Old Bluffton, Holland, O'Donnell, Chestnut, Olney, with removals to New Bluffton, Odd Fellows, Old Burnet, Post Mountain and Lone Grove.

Also in Travis County: Hudson Bend, Lehman, Marshall, Stewart Cedar Mountain, Swisher, Thurman Bend, Passe Bend, Double Horn, Pace (Page) Bend, and about 17 cemeteries on private land, with removals to "Bee Caves" Cemetery, Whiterock, Fitzhugh, Oakhill, Cedar Valley, Fiskville, Watson Hill, Marble Falls, Teck, Wallace, Post Oak Bend and others.

3. Obituaries from the Austin American newspaper are being saved, beginning January 3, 1967 and will be placed in the State Library at the end of this year.
4. Correction: From Miss Dorothy Bauer of Austin, Texas, descendant of the below names. Published in the Fall Quarterly, Sept., 1964, page 91. Fairview Cemetery. Should read: Gloeckner, Antonia (Mother) instead of Antonio (Father) (1st wife); Gloeckner, Meritz (Father) instead of Martez (Mother), born 1833, not 1883. Gloeckner, Elizabeth Michaels (2nd wife). McCUISTION CEMETERY

Located about 2 miles east of Town of Manchaca, just across Onion Creek, adjoining The Live Oak Cemetery-both in Southwestern part of Travis County just over Hays County line and approximately 4 miles north of the town of Buda. These cemeteries are close to the Old Camp Meeting grounds where annual camp meetings were held under a tabernacle by early Presbyterian settlers in the community and would usually last a week. The mode of travel was by wagon or horse and buggy. Submitted by Mrs. Ludie Jones Camp of San Marcos, Texas -(My grandfather, A.J. Hammett, donated several acres of land to the Live Oak Cemetery.)
