The only pleasant thing about having errors brought to our attention is the knowledge that AGS Quarterly is really read!

In our last issue, Vol. XV No. 1 p. 1, it was stated that Donation Certificates were given to men who had participated in the Battle of San Jacinto, but the battles at Goliad and the Alamo, the siege of Bexar (pronounced bay-har, outlanders!), and guarding the baggage at Harrisburg also entitled the veterans to such certificates. (My corrector admits that the article in The Handbook of Texas is misleading on this point, but I acknowledge that I was remiss in not checking more.)

Then in the Table of Land Measurements on the same page, change to: 1 labor is 1,000 varas square, and 1 league is 5,000 varas square.

BOOK REVIEWS

HURRICANE JUNCTION, Cyril Matthew Kuehne, S.M. San Antonio TX: privately printed, 1973. Hardback; 218 pages, 55 illustrations. \$6 postpaid (Texans add 30¢ sales tax). Order from the author at St. Mary's University, San Antonio TX 78284.

This highly enjoyable book covers the highlights of the history of Port Aransas on Mustang Island, Nueces County, Texas. No dry-as-dust history this, but one brimming over with interesting facts and anecdotes about life in the area from long before the town was founded in 1889 to the present.

Unlike some county histories, this is not just a "mug book" of men who were prominent citizens when it was written, but it does contain short sketches of the families of William R. Roberts, George Brundrett, Gail Borden Munsell, Frank Gibbs, Ralph Plumlee, "Florida" Roberts, Newt C. Curry, et al.

And for readers interested in Mercers, there is a welcome land-fall. Robert Ainsworth Mercer (born 1799 in England), who went to Mustang Island about 1852, kept a log which his sons continued. There are about 20 pages of quotations from it and their family letters, plus eight photographs of Mercers.

For present-day data, the current municipal officials, an alphabetical directory of Mustang Island residents, and a list of tourist accommodations are presented.

An aerial map of the town and surrounding waters forms the end papers, and an 1833 chart of "Aransas" Bay drawn by Captain Munroe of the Amos Wright adds charm. Some 55 excellent photographs illuminate the text. Father Kuehne regrets that delays prevented including index.

Since Port Aransas is between the Gulf of Mexico and Corpus Christi Bay, its prime concerns are the life-saving station, ships, channels, jetties, fishing, and hurricanes. The book's descriptions of these might apply to any Gulf Coast town. Cattle and sheep raising have occupied Mustang Islanders over the years, also.

Lists of ships that have served the area, of men who risked their lives to rescue crews of wrecked ships, and of notable people who have enjoyed the excellent fishing will appeal to genealogical researchers. There are sections on churches, hurricanes, shipwrecks, the lighthouse, Harbor Island Railway and Causeway, canneries (beef and turtle), the mail delivery, 1850 Nueces County officials, etc.

Hurricane Junction is remarkably free of typographical errors and awkward or antiquated construction. Clearly printed and attractively bound, it would be an enviable "parlor table volume" in any Texas home!

REPUBLIC OF TEXAS: POLL LISTS FOR 1846, compiled by Marion Day Mullins. Baltimore: Genealogical Publishing Co., Inc., 1974. Hard back; pp. 189+ii. \$15

This poll list, compiled from the original tax rolls now in the Comptroller's Office in the State Finance Building, is the nearest thing we have to a complete census of the period, for it was not un-

til 1850 that the first census of Texas as a member state of the federal union was taken. After years of political jockeying, Texas was formally admitted to the Union 29 Dec 1845, and on 16 Feb 1846, with the inauguration of newly elected state officials, the State of Texas came into being and the Republic of Texas ceased to exist.

It was a provision of the first state constitution that a "poll" tax of one dollar be levied on every white resident over the age of 21, and on women who were heads of households. Presumably, this first poll was compulsory, and thus becomes a very near approximation of the entire male population of the state. The roll of some 18,000 taxpayers represents an aggregate population of nearly 150,000 persons in Texas in 1846, estimated from the various em-presarios' totals and a calculation of those who entered individually.

Republic of Texas: Poll Lists for 1846, attractively bound in red cloth, gives the names of those whose heads were counted in strict alphabetical order. Researchers are advised to look for all possible variant spellings, as enumerators often rendered names according to the way they sounded to them. Each name is followed by that one of the 67 counties of Texas in existence in 1846 in which the taxpayer lived.

Miss Mullins, the compiler, is a highly respected genealogist who has contributed many helpful works to the nation, not the least of which are the hand-copied records of marriages of some 50 counties of Texas, now housed in the Genealogy Section of Texas State Library. We strongly recommend this, her latest publication.

THE HIGHLAND CLANS, L. G. Pine. Newton Abbot, Devon: David & Charles, Publishers, 1972. £ 3.25. Distributed in USA by Charles E. Tuttle Co., Inc., Rutland VT 05701. 191 pp. + 7 pp. index

Opening with an excellent outline of the events of the '45 Rising, The Highland Clans presents a concise account of the principal factors that had led up to the confrontation between the British army and that of the Young Pretender. The defeat of his army, chiefly Highlanders, and their subsequent oppression resulted in the massive migration (and/or deportation) of Scots to North America. Thus it was one of the most significant battles of history for American genealogists.

Next, Mr. Pine recounts the origin of the Gael, the history of Celtic monarchy, the struggles and culture of the clans (with separate chapters devoted to the 16th and 17th centuries), differences between Highlander and Lowlander, much military and political history, a detailed chronicle of the campaign of 1745, and a poignant summation of the breaking up of the clan system.

This prolific author excels at compressing a maximum of information into one sentence, which explains the vast quantity of history and exposition found in this small book. I cannot refrain from mentioning, however, that his use of the simple past tense for the past perfect often forced me to go back several sentences in order to properly orient a statement which by the tense seemed to contradict the one preceeding it.

Two amusing proofreading errors were noticed: on page 81, feign (pretend) for fain (constrained); and on 111, the omission of t from attainting completely reversed the meaning, it seems.

For each chapter there are one to two pages of notes, helpfully headed by the page numbers covered as well as the chapter number. The index is thorough and very legible.

The Highland Clans is a valuable book to keep at hand, whether your ancestors were Highlanders or Lowlanders. If you have no Scottish ancestors, you should read it to learn what all the feuding was about!

KNOX COUNTY, TENNESSEE MARRIAGES, 1792-1900, Roscoe C. d'Armand and daughter Virginia. 8½ x 11", 1,100 pages. \$25 from Miss d'Armand, 1205 Southgate R., S.W., Knoxville TN 37919

Containing more than 100,000 names, this volume sets forth marriage data compiled from licenses, bonds, registers, WPA typescripts, and newspaper accounts--a godsend for those with ancestors in this area, which was created in 1792 from Greene and Hawkins counties. Miss d'Armand also shares her expertise in research and transcribing very reasonably.

A MIRACLE!

Rare indeed is the recovery of a family Bible, once it is lost, but it can happen if people are thoughtful. In fact, it happened right here in Austin just recently.

An AGS member has been instrumental in restoring a long-lost Bible to the son of the original owners. The Bible was brought to the member by Walter White who found it 15 years ago when demolishing a house. Instead of discarding it, he and his wife Mary took care of the Bible until she mentioned to our member that she wished she could return it to the family.

The Bible had belonged to Augustus Markam Gribble who was married 29 Nov 1882 to Jennie C. King by Saml. A. King, pastor of the Presbyterian Church in Waco TX. A phone call to Mr. A. M. Gribble Jr. in Austin verified that he was indeed a child of that marriage and, needless to say, was overjoyed at the miraculous resurfacing of the revered volume.

This marriage would seem to have had a firm foundation: Sarah Lane Derrier married Edwin Cady Butts. (If you don't have a French dictionary, just ask the man who owns one!)
