CLIPS AND QUIPS

Spreading Family Tree

(Clipped from an old <u>Country Life</u>, a perfectly beautiful weekly magazine published in England)

"'A very tedious peece of work and very chargable for I have doon it upon the best writing velam I could buy,' wrote the compiler of the Darell family's pedigree in 1637; and its tediousness is not entirely surprising, for the pedigree covers 65 square feet of parchment. It was among the items in an exhibition of heraldic documents held in the art gallery of the Public Library at Tunbridge Wells, Kent. ... The Darell pedigree, which is 20 feet long, was prepared for Sir Robert Darell of Calehill by John Taylor, and is of exceptional interest not only for its fictitious portraits of some members of the family, but also for its addition of copies of deeds, brasses and sepulchral monuments. Taylor commented at the time: 'There will be I ame sure above 5 hundred coates yett I have nott counted them.' One can only hope that he was adequately rewarded for his very chargeable labours."

A reader made an amusing comment about our new cover design (which she described as fascinating). She thought the bare limb of the "family tree" might represent a skeleton in the closet that a researcher discovered, and hence did not enfoliate that branch further! I ascribed a more prosaic symbolism to the branch: a member of the family died childless. But, to be more optimistic, we could consider it a branch whose twigs may leaf out next spring. Here's hoping there will be no dead-end branches on your family tree!

In the Oct 20, 1966, issue of <u>Country Life</u> appeared a full-page colored advertisement for White Horse Whisky. Above pictures of an old castle before which sheep grazed on the greensward, a smit of armor, and stained-glass windows depicting coats of arms, is this light-hearted advice:

"Live Like a Lord! To be an Aristocrat you need: Some very old ancestors in the thirteenth century...Some very rapacious ancestors in the eighteenth century...White Horse Whisky in the cellar...

"The key to being an aristocrat is survival. You need ancestors to prove you've survived. That's the trick. It helps if they were rich. To found your line you need someone in the thirteenth century with a name like Angle the Jute. He was just there to lay down the real estate. He probably drank mead. Forget him. Ideally your great-great-grandfather should have been a pirate. This gives the coffers a shot in the arm. Coming to more civilised times, an aristocrat should cultivate his park and palate. For the park, very old trees, and a lawn like a billiard table. And, for the palate, White Horse Whisky,...For an aristocrat is simply a whisky connoisseur...."

If whiskey-drinking ancestors were the only criterion, some of us would be lords indeed!

ly and Kinsmen by Wm Harrison Polk, 1912: "In a letter received from J.M. Sears, of San Marcos, this state, one of the family, says:

'Your inquiry has been handed to me by my uncle, Frank M. Polk, of In reply I am sending you all of the information that he knows in regard to his family. Warnell Polk, son of Taylor Polk, was born in Arkansas. Taylor Polk died when Warnell was seven years old; his mother died four years later.

'After his mother's death, Warnell came to Texas and stopped in Bastrop Co. with Jim Weaver, but left him when 14 years old and was taken in by Dr. D.F. Brown of Prairie Lea, Texas, and lived with Dr. Brown until he married Miss Irene Myers.'"

MILES BYRNE

In 1847 Miles Byrne arrived in Philadelphia from Ireland. In the early 50°s he came to Galveston, Texas. He was a carpenter and cabinet maker. Hearing that there was work to be found in the construction on the new capitol building, he came to Austin. During the Civil War he made and repaired wagons for the army. He and his partner had their shop on Congress Avenue.

On. Nov. 4, 1856 he married another Irish immigrant, Mary Smith. In 1857 their marriage was blessed and on record as the seventh at St. Patrick's Catholic Church. In due time they had eight boys. In 1877 they bought 175 acres five miles south of Austin, a part of the Santiago del Valle tract. At the time it had a stone building, used as a blacksmith shop, a grist mill, other buildings, a stock tank, and land that was good for farming. Burleson Road ran along the west and south sides.

There have been many changes since then. The old stone building is the only one still standing. Ben White was cut through the original land. In 1955 the old blacksmith shop was renovated into a home by one of his granddaughters and her husband, Alfred and Marguerite Byrne Brown. They are still living there today at 83 and 81. One of their daughters and her husband, Lou and Mary Frances Kiefer, live across the stock tank from them. Another granddaughter and her husband, Al and Lucille Bieter, live on another part of the original land. Up the hill where the original farmhouse stood, is the site of St. Peter's Church, on land given by Bernard Byrne, one of the sons of Mary and Miles Byrne.

JULGE SEBRON GRAHAM SNEED

Judge S. G. Sneed, wife Miranda Adkins Sneed, nine of their eleven children, accompanied by slaves, hogs and cattle, started from Fayetteville, Arkansas Oct. 1, 1848 headed for Austin. The trip took around two months since the pace was set by the hogs, the slowest animals.

Judge Sneed bought a block of ground in 1850 between Rio Grande and West, and what is now 10th and 11th streets. He built a large log cabin with a kitchen and slave quarters in back. This was home until the permanent house could be built on Comal Bluff, the name given to the 700 acres on what is now the old Lockhar& Road.

The plans for the big stone house were drawn by Abner H. Cook, a well known architect and contractor of that time. As stated in Minor and Major Mansions in Austin, by A. W. Harris, the work started in 1852 by the partnership of Sims, the rock-mason and Miles Byrne, the carpenter. It took five years to build, with the war clouds stopping work before the finish.

As interesting note is that later a granddaughter of S. G. Sneed married a son of Miles Byrne. These were my grandparents.
