## AN 1827 LIST OF OFFICERS AND SOLDIERS OF THE REVOLUTIONARY ARMY

A Bicentennial Project

The native Americans and the Spanish padres and soldiers in their missions and presidios in Texas did nothing to aid the cause of the American Revolution. It is doubtful that many 18th Century Texans, immersed in their own struggles for survival, even heard of the fateful war being waged on the eastern seaboard.

But in order to get on the bandwagon, Texas Bicentennial Committees have inaugurated many fine projects that will stand as monuments to present-day patriotism.

So, although the rationale of a connection between Spanish Texas and the original thirteen colonies from 1776 to 1784 may be "pretty farfetched," AGS Quarterly makes this gesture in the nationwide Bicentennial "point-with-pride" movement: an attempt to make more accessible a bit of historical record connected with the American Revolution. It ties in with the gift made in this Bicentenary Year to Texas State Library by Austin Genealogical Society: a \$300 set of certain volumes of the American State Papers, since the original ones in the Library are too fragile to Xerox. These are the volumes that are indexed in Grass Roots.

We have alphabetized this "List of Officers and Soldiers of the Revolutionary Army Entitled to Bounty Land Who Have Not Received It: Communicated to the Senate January 15, 1828." The list is found in American State Papers. Documents of the Congress of the United States, in Relation to the Public Lands . . ., Volume V pp. 360-75.

Although these soldiers were not Texans, it is devoutly hoped that some of their descendants are, and will be able, by means of a clue given here, to identify some Revolutionary ancestors.

On 27 Dec 1827, Mr. Johnson of Kentucky communicated to the Senate "a document from the Department of War, containing a list of such warrants as have been issued for officers and soldiers of the revolutionary army that remain on the files of the bounty land office unclaimed," which list appears on the following pages with the original headings. Since the names have been put in alphabetical order, it was decided NOT TO RETYPE THEM INTO THE ANNUAL INDEX WHICH CONCLUDES THIS ISSUE.

In List No. 1, O.S. must mean Old Series, for the numbering seems to start over where N.S. (New Series?) appears in the margin.

In List No. 2, the entries in the "Rank" column following the officers actually read "Privates, &c" for the first of each group and "do" (for "ditto") for each of the following soldiers, so some of them were not privates but sergeants, corporals, etc.

But what a break for you lucky researchers whose ancestors bore rare names such as Abraham Catchsides, Daniel Godsgrace, Christopher Hopingstock, Valentine Leighton, Goodwill Lively, Jeffrey Huzzard, and Charles J. Emanuel Lambert! Finding them here could be your entrée into DAR or similar

If only he had used that editorial discretion in interpreting the surnames, we would not be puzzled by such highly unlikely spellings as Guitman, Sheyman, Goldthrite, Keymour, Boinside, Calluhon, Colisle, Gallahn, and Wan Nout. Were they typographical errors, errors in interpreting what was written, the company clerk's guess at the preferred spelling, or the way the soldier really spelled his name?

USING THE BRANCH LIBRARY OF THE CHURCH OF  
JESUS CHRIST OF LATTER-DAY SAINTS

By Mrs. Charles B. Croft

The Branch Library of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints is a unique library designed to make more widely available to the members of the Church living away from Salt Lake City the vast collection of genealogical material housed in the Society's main library and other storage facilities.

Present Status. The Genealogical Society is the largest such organization in the world. Its main library now contains over 125,000 volumes, with some 5,000 additions a year. Over 80 microfilm cameras throughout the world supply approximately 50,000 new rolls each year; the collection is approaching one million rolls.

About 6,000,000 family group sheets are filed in the Church Records Archives, and 30,000,000 cards are in the Temple Records Index Bureau file. In addition, millions of names have been computer-stored (this file is now known as the Computer File).

Over 150 professional genealogists have been accredited by the Society, and more than 100 Research Papers have been published to guide genealogists in the genealogical records of twenty or more countries. The Papers, in notebooks, may be examined at the Branch Library.

When visiting the Branch Library one should allow time to become familiar with the printed Guide. Its purpose is to explain how to obtain microfilm from the Genealogical Society for use at a branch genealogical library.

Most of the Society's microfilms can be borrowed for two weeks or six months, usually with renewal privilege. Each branch library keeps a collection of important reference materials on microfilm. No film on loan can be taken from the branch library premises.

Current Charges in Austin: Two-week loan 50¢; one-week renewal 25¢; two-week renewal 50¢.

Indefinite loan \$5; change to indefinite loan \$5 less credit for previous loan and renewal fee.

Six-month loan \$3; change to six-month loan \$3 less credit as above.

Basic Book List microfilms, Three- and Four-Generation Family Group Record form microfilms on indefinite loan, and other microfilms on indefinite loan, specifically indicated by the Genealogical Society--\$3.

Structure of the Microfilmed Catalog. The microfilm edition of the Genealogical Society's card catalog is divided into three parts: 1. Locality--those cards which describe the records of geographical areas; 2. Surname--cards pertaining to family histories and other biographical information; and 3. Subject--cards pertaining to LDS Church records and records of American Indians plus general subjects such as heraldry, genealogy, etc.

Procedure for Ordering Microfilms. When you locate desired material in the catalog, obtain a Microfilm Request form and complete items 1 through 8 plus item 13. BE SURE TO RECORD THE FILM NUMBER CORRECTLY. When the microfilm reaches the Branch Library (usually a couple of weeks) you will be notified by phone or mail.

Although the microfilmed catalog contains cards describing genealogical books as well as film, books are not circulated to branch li-

braries because of the risk of loss or damage to rare and sometimes fragile books. But it is helpful to read descriptions of these books on their cards and then seek them in local libraries.

Explanation of "Guide to Locality Films." The localities in this section are listed from general to specific in the following sequence: Collection; General area containing more than one country, if any; Country; General area of the country, if any; State or province; County; City, township, parish, etc.

This section contains a list of the Genealogical Society's holdings for each locality. The films will be arranged in sequence as listed above. For example, cards for cities appear after cards for the county to which they belong. To evaluate the complete holdings for a locality it is necessary to check the regular locality films, the filmed registers, and any new supplement films.

Using the Locality Portion of the Catalog.

1. Determine the general collection by looking up the name of the country in the Alphabetic List of Geographic Areas. For example, Samoa is in the Afro-Asian Collection. This list contains cross-references from old names to current ones, such as "Borneo SEE Indonesia."
2. Locate the wanted collection in the Guide to Locality Films.
3. Examine the geographic headings listed under the collection title until the locality of interest is found, then copy the microfilm roll number located beside the locality entry. If this guide does not contain a reference to the desired locality, check the register to the old filming of the card catalog. If the locality is listed therein, copy the roll and supplement numbers located beside the locality entry.
4. Obtain this film from the library attendant. "Scan" the cards or registers shown on the film until the geographic area desired is seen.
5. Records of counties are listed in alphabetical order by county within each country or state.
6. Records of cities, townships, parishes, etc., are interfiled in alphabetic order within each county.

The records for each geographic area are listed under subject headings. These headings are designed to put similar records together.

Explanation of the Guide to Surname Films. Surname cards are arranged alphabetically, regardless of residence. Major surnames in any given work are entered alphabetically, so one work may be listed under several surnames. Of course, time and space limitations prohibit listing a book under surnames that are barely mentioned. This is a recent project, so some of the older family history and biographical works at the Society may not be listed here yet.

The Guide to Subject Films covers material not in the Locality or Surname portions of the Microfilmed Card Catalog. Exception: Indians of a particular locality are listed both there and here. Subjects are filed in alphabetical order; the patron is advised to check all appropriate subjects. Where possible the terms used are those contained in the Library of Congress's List of Subject Headings.

Before proceeding with genealogical research in England, Wales, Scotland, Denmark, Norway, Sweden, Prussia, Luxembourg, and certain New England states of the United States, a person should determine whether the parish records of interest have been included in the Controlled Extraction program. To determine this, he examines Computer Parish Listing.

Controlled Extraction program--a Church program, formerly known as the Records Tabulation or R-Tab program, whereby names are extracted from parish and town records and sent to the temple, where ordinance work is

performed for the individuals. As part of this program, ordinance lists are produced which show the names and ordinance dates for the individuals whose names have been extracted. Often alphabetized computer printouts are produced, showing names and genealogical information contained in the town or parish records. Microfilms of ordinance lists and parish or town printouts are available on loan to the branch libraries.

Computer Parish Listing - A list of the parishes and towns whose records have been included in the Controlled Extraction program. This is arranged by geographical area and alphabetically by name of Parish or town thereunder. The list includes the film numbers for the microfilmed ordinance lists and computer parish and town printouts mentioned above. It is revised yearly and is distributed to stake and mission presidents of English-speaking areas of the world.

Accredited Researchers. Each branch genealogical library has a list of professional genealogical researchers who have passed an exhaustive accreditation examination administered by the Genealogical Society. Most professionals are accredited to research in a specific area. The patron must make his own contacts and contracts with these individuals, whose fees, experience, and places of residence will vary.

The Branch Genealogical Library in Austin is financed, staffed, and maintained by the members of the Austin Texas Stake as an aid in carrying out a sacred responsibility--searching the records for their ancestors and doing Temple work for them; however, we are happy to share our facilities with our non-member friends. It is a pleasure to see people develop a sense of pride in their ancestry and our staff will continue to look forward to serving those who "drop in" to see what we have or to do serious research.

## BOOK REVIEW

AMSLERS OF AUSTIN'S COLONY. Compiled by Amanda (Howze) Amsler (Mrs. Hervey Meyer Amsler, 3435 Westheimer Road, Apt. 505, Houston TX 77027). Privately printed, 1976. Pp. xv + 291. Color and black-and-white illustrations. Cloth-bound; 7 x 10½. \$25 (from compiler)

This handsome book documents the Amsler family of Austin County, Texas, and traces their lineage through eight generations in Switzerland before their migration to America. Arriving in New Orleans in 1833, Charles Conrad Amsler and wife Mary (nee Anna Maria Leuenberger) traveled up the Mississippi River to St. Louis, Missouri where they lived a few months before returning to New Orleans. Impressed by glowing descriptions of Texas, they moved on to the area that is now Cat Spring in Austin County, Texas, arriving in July 1834. The combination of family tradition with historical research has produced a most enjoyable story of this early Texas family and the descendants.

Rapidly becoming loyal Texans, Amsler men fought in the war for independence from Mexico, the Civil War, and both "world wars." They contributed to the upbuilding of their adopted state by farming, milling grain and lumber, hauling cotton to the Rio Grande to aid the Confederacy, merchandising, railroading, banking, teaching, and healing. They became lawyers, editors, civil servants, scientists, executives. One title they all shared: "Good Citizen."

The discussion of the various Amsler coats of arms has been very deftly handled by the editor/ghost writer, our own Helen Hoskins Rugeley. Profuse illustrations of persons, places, heirlooms, and family documents add much interest. The pertinent Amsler coat of arms is gold-embossed on the blue cover.

The front and back end papers respectively feature maps of colonial Texas and the area of Switzerland where this Amsler family lived. Supplements provide valuable documentation of the family's history and include land records, military records, letters, recollections, etc. An unusual inclusion is several pages of family signatures, plus sixteen blank pages for Notes (additions and corrections).

A number of allied families besides Amsler are sketched; to name a few: Schaffner, Welhausen, Hediger, Reitsch, Byrnes, Bailey, Wildi, Mathis, Schluep, Seeberger, Brueggmann, Gross, Hillboldt, and their descendants, too numerous to list in this review.

Such a beautiful and well-done book deserves an index, and this reviewer regrets that one was not provided. This lack is partially compensated for by the arrangement of the table of contents and by the running heads which show the names of those who are sketched on each page. The genealogical section brings the family up to date, including some born in the year of publication. Each person is identified as to generation and parents, making it relatively easy to locate any given member of the family.

## BOOK REVIEW.

CEMETERY INSCRIPTIONS, RUNNELS COUNTY, TEXAS. Volume I. Compiled by Frank Duane Jenkins, 508 Fourth St., Ballinger TX 76821. Published by San Angelo Genealogical and Historical Society, Inc., 1976. Pp. ii + 101 (including 11-page surname index). \$6 postpaid; order from the compiler.

This neat volume with attractive cardstock cover could well serve as a model for any group or person wishing to present cemetery inscriptions to eagerly waiting genealogists. The cover is quite distinctive with an original design symbolizing two centuries of America. Utilizing two century plants (representative of the hardiness of West Texas and its people), one upright and one inverted, surrounded by the words "Bicentennial 1976 in Ballinger," the eye-catching and thought-provoking device also pays tribute to those who copied the inscriptions--the Ballinger Bicentennial Task Force made up of high school students and their director. No doubt this colophon will be used on subsequent volumes, for the task force has already copied the inscriptions in all known cemeteries in Runnels County.

Volume I covers Evergreen Cemetery, the largest in Ballinger, and Garden of Memories, opened in 1956, which adjoins the former. In the introductory data, a diagram showing the location of Evergreen is followed by one showing the positions of the six sections and (in their respective places) detailed maps of each section.

In the Preface, Mr. Jenkins states that all military and genealogical data were copied, but not the epitaphs. He has added (underlined or in parentheses) all available data of that nature which is believed to be correct, and solicits additions and corrections so that they may be included in the last volume to be typed.

Especially well done is the section summarizing the history of cemeteries in Ballinger. The whole book is neat, readable, informative, and apparently accurate, but the section maps leave a bit to be desired in legibility. Mr. Jenkins is to be commended for arranging the data so that the relative positions of the graves is shown and for supplying an index to at least the surnames.

Austin Genealogical Society is grateful to the compiler for his gift of a copy of Cemetery Inscriptions, Runnels County, Texas, Volume I, which will be placed in the Genealogy Department of Texas State Library where it will be accessible to all.

(her brother-in-law) in Mecklenburg Co., NC. I am seeking information on this Archibald McNeal. Was he a son of Archibald McNeill (various spellings), one of 350 "Scotch gentlemen and several poor People" who came to NC with Dugald McNeal and Col. Hector McAlister in 1739? They settled in Bladen Co. and (later) Cumberland where in 1778 an Archibald McNeill escaped deportation by belatedly taking "the oath of fidelity to the State." Many references to this man are in Colonial Records of North Carolina by Wm. L. Saunders.

Our Archibald McNeal married Martha, daughter of Thomas Sprout or Spratt who died in Anson Co. in 1757. Martha (Spratt) McNeal died between 26 Sep 1775 (date of her will) and 26 Oct 1775 (sale of her estate). Their children were Prudence (details wanted) and Thomas (b. 1771) who married Clarissa Polk.
