# NEW ORLEANS GREYS Muster Roll of Cooke's Company

On 13 Oct 1835, a crowd gathered at Bank's Arcade in New Orleans and responded generously to the call for funds to help the Texans in their struggle against Mexican oppression. Then Adolphus Sterne of Nacogdoches offered rifles to the first 50 volunteers who would accompany him back to Texas. About 118 men responded and formed two companies, calling themselves the New Orleans Greys. (The Texan Committee gave them fine gray uniform caps and coats, according to Yoakum's <u>History of Texas</u>, Vol. II, p. 23.)

The unit there recruited by Capt. Robert C. Morris sailed on the Columbus to the mouth of the Brazos and proceeded thence to San Antonio, which was held by the Mexican forces. The other company, under Capt. Thomas H. Breece, will be described in a later article.

Reaching the Texans' camp outside San Antonio de Bexar, Morris was promoted to major and William G. Cooke appointed to his place as The besieging force had been rapidly diminishing as the volunteers chafed at inaction and slipped away. Reinforcement by the New Orleans Greys may well have contributed to the decision of Col. Benjamin Rush Milam to utter his famous cry, "Who will go with old Ben Milam into San Antonio?"

Three hundred men volunteered to go against almost 1200 Mexicans under Gen. Martin Perfecto de Cos. A description of the assault, generally called the Siege of Bexar, can be found in The Handbook of Texas (Vol. I, P. 154) and in most history books. (Afterwards, the volunteers, renamed the San Antonio Greys, either joined James Grant for the Matamoros Expedition or went to J. W. Fannin at Goliad. The majority perished in the Battle of Agua Dulce Creek or the Goliad Massacre.)

At Bexar, the first division was under the command of Colonel Milam, assisted by Lt. Col. Nidland Franks of the artillery and Major R. C. Morris of the Greys. Their guides/scouts were Samuel A. Maverick, Hendrick Arnold, and --- Cooke, recorded Yoakum. Col. Francis/ Frank W. Johnson's report (John Henry Brown's History of Texas, Vol. I, p. 419) named Erastus [Deaf] Smith, Kendrick Arnold and John W. Smith as the guides.

Documents pertaining to this Siege of Bexar which Mrs. J. B. Golden found and copied in the Texas State Archives consist of five Muster Rolls and two "Detailed Reports." Men on the first muster are (with few exceptions) found on the "Detailed Report of Names of those persons who Volunteered and formed the Second Division in the attack on San Antonio de Bexar and entered the house of Berramender [Veramendi] on the night of the 5th of Decr 1835 under Command of Col. F.M. Johnston [Francis W. Johnson] assisted by Cols. J. Grant & W.T. Austin, Adjt N[athaniel] R. Brister & Dr. Jno Cameron." Name # 96 is Capt. Wm. G. Cooke; on the muster roll set forth below, the numbers after the names of his men show their positions on this "Detailed Report."

Each man who participated in the Siege of Bexar was entitled to a Donation Certificate, as well as a Bounty Warrant granting him land

in proportion to the length of his service (ca 320 acres per three months) in the Army of Texas. I have placed such information (found in T. L. Miller's Bounty and Donation Land Grants of Texas) after the name of each veteran, including variant spelling, if any. The order of the muster roll is maintained, even if not strictly alphabetical.

Abbreviations used represent this format: (1) Veteran received Donation Certificate for --- acres on --- [date] for participation in the Siege of Bexar [5-9 Dec 1835] or for having been killed at Goliad or having "fallen with Fannin" [27 Mch 1836]. --- acres were patented to the veteran (or heirs) in --- County on --- [date]. Or, the grant was patented by an assignee to whom the volunteer had sold or given his certificate.

(2) Veteran received Bounty Warrant for --- acres on --- for service in the Army from 22 Oct 1835 until ---. [Some joined the New Orleans Greys later; a few had prior service.] It is advisable to study Mr. Miller's book (which gives the number of each certificate and warrant, and other information) and/or the original grants to see the names of heirs and assignees. CAUTION: There is no assurance that the veteran ever lived on the land he received, or that he was alive when it was patented, even if it says "patented to him."

Some of the names on the muster roll do not appear in Cooke's company on the "Detailed Report" (or vice versa), which bears the notation "The foregoing roll is very imperfect." These documents are obviously copied--"Rees" interpreted "Run," "S." for "L.", etc.

Part 10

This continuing feature is a compilation of data found in the National Archives Microfilm Publications Microcopy No. 278. For an explanation, see pp. 113-114 of AGS Quarterly XIX:4.

Thinking that readers would be interested in knowing how many of these soldiers remained in Texas after the war, we have looked them up on the 1850 census. First we examine the <u>Accelerated Index to the 1850 Census of Texas</u> for a name that closely resembles that of a soldier. When there are several, we look on the microfilm at one in the county where he enlisted, if we have his age to check against. If the microfilm is illegible, we consult Mrs. V. K. Carpenter's printed 1850 census of Texas.

Therefore, in the list which follows, an asterisk precedes each name which bears a reasonable resemblance to one that appears in the 1850 census. With the more common names there is, of course, less assurance of identity. REMEMBER: These are just possibilities—we do not guarantee that the man on the census was the soldier. But by showing all the details given in the census, we hope to enable the readers to locate their ancestors. Many may be found in the <u>Handbook of Texas</u>, especially Volume III, the new supplement.

# A Reminder About "Ancestor Listings"

This feature is for <u>paid-up</u> members only. Queries are accepted from non-members, but in order to have two pages in the June issue you must send in your dues <u>before May Day</u>, from now on.

If you want four pages, you'll have to pay for a family membership; for three pages, you may team up with a member who submits only

one page.

Your editor does not want to make it difficult for you, but if we did not have any requirements, people might say, "Meetings and entries in the quarterly are free, so why pay dues?" Or, "What is the incentive to pay more for a family membership?" The quarterly would soon starve to death.

We warn you in the last issue of the year that all dues are payable on or before New Year's Day. [We set two red-letter days to help you remember.] The Newsletter carries notices, and the March quarterly announces "This is your last free issue." (Then if you do not pay up, the Society is out the cost of that issue.) But still some of you repeatedly forget to meet your responsibility until an already overworked member phones or writes you.

Another instruction often ignored is about the margins of your pages of ancestor data. If you will lay your sheets on a table, facing each other, and place an <u>AGS Quarterly</u> over them (face down for the left-hand page), you will see how the staples and holes may ob-

scure some of your data.

In that case, I have to trim off part of the outer margin and paste it to widen the inner margin. For printed charts, that often cuts off the name of the publisher so it has to be reversed before being attached on the back with Magic Tape, leaving a white margin on the front.

Now your editor is all thumbs, but many of you are nimble-fingered, so you could do a neater job of it than I do. If you can send in your sheets all ready to go to the printer's, I'll really appreciate it: --HHR

Pierre COQUAT married Jeanne Victoria GUYON. Both were born near Grenoble, now in the Department of Isere, France, and both were killed in an accident while their son Lucian Claud was very young.

The exact order of their children is not now known, but Mrs. Pierce's grandfather seems to have been the youngest, for tradition says he was "raised by Louise and Marie and brought to America by Joseph and August."

- i. Louise married Isadore VOIDIER (who possibly died in a concentration camp); three children known:
  - a. Marie born ca 1871; died during the 1941-43 Occupation.
  - b. Henri born ca 1873; married but had no issue; d. 1941-43.

SIDON JOHN HARRIS - My Gr-Gr-Gr-Grandfather - Who were his parents?

He was born about 1780, probably Virginia and was in the 1820 Census of Overton County, Tennessee. The 1830 Madison Co. Tenn Census shows him, too. He served during the War of 1812 from Overton Co. By 1 August 1855 he was living in Haywood County, Tenn. No known date of death, or place. Supposedly married a Hawkins or Crockett girl. Known sons:

- 1. <u>John Harris</u> rode to Texas with David Crockett and died at the Alamo. Reportedly first cousin of Crockett.





#### IGO-ANSON CHRONOLOGY

- Lewis Igo was in Baltimore Co., MD before 1735. (REISTER'S DESIRE by Bayley, p. 128.)
- 2. Lewis Igo patented "Friends' Discovery" 21 July 1737--Baltimore Co.
- 3. William Igo born 22 April 1729 to Lewis and Mary Igo--birth registered at St. Paul's Parish in Baltimore Co., MD.
- 4. William Igo bought 'Cornelius and Mary's Lot,: 200 acres 21 July 1858 and "Igou's String," 7½ acres in 1794. (Balt. Land Grants) He was taxed for Soldiers' Delight Hundres in 1763.
- 5. William Igo married Elizabeth\_\_\_\_. Had nine known children.
- 6. Lewis Igo's will dated 2 March 1760 and probated 16 April 1760.
- 7. Henry Hansel/Ansel bought 142 acres in 'Murray's Plains" in 1764. (Hall of Records Index, St. John's College, Annapolis, MD.)
- 8. Jacob Igo born ca 1774, probably in Baltimore Co., MD to William and Elizabeth Igo.
- 9. Philaris (Philarious) Ansel, son of Henry, was married to Catherine
  . After his death, Catherine married Michael Hose in 1788.

  (Baltimore Sun.) The known Ansel/Anson children were: Henry,
  Francis, and Elizabeth.
- 10. William Igo died intestate between 1794 and 13 April 1805. (REISTER'S DESIRE, p. 129.)
- 11. Philaris Anzel/Ansel/Anson, son of Henry, owned part of "Murray's Plains."
  - 12. "Henry Anzel/Ansel, kin-at-law of his father, Philaris Ansel, sold part of "Murray's Plains Regulated" for 168 lbs. 15 schillings to John Yohn 24 Aug. 1803." (R. DESIRE, p. 171) Michael Hose and wife Catherine deeded George Gore and John Yohn their interest in the Ansel land. (p. 172)
  - 13. Henry Anson married Elizabeth Buerly/Bioly (Bailey ?) 26 Aug. 1803. She was the daughter of Peter Bioly.
- 14. Henry Anson bought land in Logan Co., KY 6 Dec. 1803.
- 15. Henry Ansel conveyed to Elizabeth Ansel 15 Oct. 1804 for 5 schillings part of "Murray's Plains Regulated" which was conveyed to his mother 24 Aug. 1803 as her share of his father's estate.
- 16. Henry Hansel/Ansel, Elizabeth Hansel/Ansel, Michael Hose and wife Catherine deeded 48 acres in "Murray's Plains Regulated" to John Worthington in Baltimore Co., MD 12 Sept. 1805.

- 17. Henry Ansel sold land to Michael Hose/Hoss and wife of Baltimore Co. Sept. 1805.
- 18. Jacob Igo sold his 12th part of his father's estate, "Cornelius and Mary's Lot," to his brother, Joshua 13 April 1805 in Baltimore Co., MD. (Deeds of Baltimore Co.)
- 19. Jacob Igo married Elizabeth Ansen/Anson in Logan Co., KY 18 Dec. 1805.
  Francis Anson m. Sally O'Neill Dec. 1805 in Logan Co., KY.
  - 20. The Jacob Igo, Henry Anson, Francis Anson, and Michael Hoss families lived near each other in Logan Co., KY (1810 census) All were still there in 1820 except Francis who lived in Simpson Co., KY.
  - 21. Jacob Igo served in the War of 1812, 17th U.S. Infantry, and was discharged at Chillicothe, Ohio 7 June 1815.
  - 22. There was a Thomas Bayley, Sheriff of Baltimore Co. in 1800 (p. 114, REISTER'S DESIRE), and a Thomas Bailey was tax collecter there in 1805.
  - 23. Henry's wife was Elizabeth (Buerly) Bailey/Bayley, so perhaps Thomas Bailey/Bayley was related and that is why Henry gave that address when he was visiting there in 1820.
  - 24. In 1820, Henry Anson made a trip to Baltimore. Jacob Igo gave him his discharge and power of attorney to try to get the land warrant for his service in the War of 1812. Henry wrote a letter to Washington from Baltimore and said to send the warrant to him in care of Thomas Bailey, Harrison St., No. 10, Baltimore. Test: Thomas Bailey.
  - 25. Jacob Igo was granted land in Prairie Co., Arkansas in 1821--Bounty Land Warrant #24864.
  - 26. William Igo was born in Kentucky 15 Jan. 1810 and his brother, Lewis, was born ca 1811 to Jacob and Elizabeth Anson Igo. There were at least four sisters, but no names are known. (Buffalo Cemetery, Pike Co.)
  - 27. The Igo, Anson, and some Hoss families moved to Pike Co., Missouri between 1823-1825. They were in Pike Co. in 1830 (census). The last land sale in Logan Co., KY was 12 Nov. 1825 by Henry and Elizabeth Anson. (Their name is found spelled Anson in Kentucky.)
  - 28. William and Lewis Igo fought in the Black Hawk War in Illinois in 1832. Lewis later received a Bounty Land Warrant in Taney County, Missouri.
  - 29. William Igo m. Mary Carr Montgomery in Pike Co., MO 20 Dec. 1832. They remained in Pike Co. where they reared eight children.
  - 30. Jacob, William and Lewis Igo owned land in Lincoln Co., MO in the 1830's. Jacob Igo was in Lincoln Co. when the 1840 census was taken near Anson and Hoss families.
  - 31. Lewis Igo m. Elvirey Allen 23 Jan. 1838 in Greene Co., MO. They lived in Taney Co., Washington Twp. (1840 and 1850 censuses). In 1860 they were in Buchanan Twp. with five children. (1860 census)

- 32. Elvirey Allen Igo died ca. 1861 and Lewis Igo m. Galletta Foster Bradley ca 1862. Whe was the widow of Seth Henry Bradley and had five children.
- 33. Jacob Martin Igo was born 12 March 1863 near Roy in Taney Co., MO to Lewis and Galletta Igo. Three other sons were born to them.
- 34. No dates of death have been found for Lewis or Galletta Igo. Lewis is thought to have died ca 1878, and Galletta is thought to have died about 1882. Her grave is in the Bradleyville Cemetery by her first husband, but there is no marker now.
- 35. Jacob M. Igo m. Rebecca Jane Johnson 6 Aug. 1890 in Taney County. (Marriage License) She was daughter of Francis Marion Johnson and Malinda Jane Barnett. They had eleven children--eight born in Taney Co., MO, and three born in Oklahoma.
- 36. Jacob and Rebecca Igo and family moved to Indian Territory in OK ca 1903, stayed a year, moved back to MO--Lawrence Co., and then returned to Oklahoma ca 1906.
- 37. George Washington Igo was born in Taney County, MO 13 Feb. 1892 to Jacob M. and Rebecca Igo.
- 38. George W. Igo m. Winnie Ellen O'Neal 12 March 1920 in Fletcher, OK. She is the daughter of Robert Wesley O'Neal and Maggie Jane Currie. They had nine children--six born in Oklahoma and four born in Cochran Co., TX.
- 39. Louis Martin Igo was born in Grady Co., OK 24 May 1927 to George W. and Winnie Igo. The family moved to Cochran Co., TX in 1933.
- 40. Louis M. Igo m. June Kathryn Jones 5 June 1948 in Cochran Co., TX. She is the daughter of Charlie Busey Jones and Mildred Leola Anderson. They have three children: Linda Diane Cobb, Larry Paul Igo, and Glenda Nell Igo.
- 41. Larry P. Igo m. Joan Lanette Topham 28 July 1973 in Alta Loma, TX. She is the daughter of Keith Topham and Catherine King. They have one daughter, Audrey Frances Igo, born 21 December 1979.

# ANDERSON ANCESTORS

### By June Jones Igo

Our first known Anderson ancestor was Wesley A. Anderson who was born in South Carolina according to the 1850 census. His tombstone gives his date of birth as November 30, 1799 and date of death as May 5, 1855. There is a record of his marriage to Frances Harris April 25, 1821 in Baldwin Co., Georgia. She was born April 19, 1806 in Georgia and died July 6, 1902. Both Wesley and Frances are buried in the High Pine Baptist Church Cemetery near Roanoke in Randolph Co., Alabama.

At the time of the 1830 census, Wesley and Frances were in Talbot Co., GA. The census shows that they had four children--three boys and one girl. We

only know the names of two boys born before 1830--Zachariah and John Priar Anderson. In 1840, they were in Choctaw Co., MS., Northern District, with six boys and three girls in their family. Two males, 30-40 were listed, one of which was Wesley A. The other one may have been a relative or a helper on the farm.

Talbot Co. was in western Georgia and was created in 1827. Choctaw Co., MS was created in 1833 after the Chickasaw Cession of 1832. In this north central area of Mississippi, cotton growing was widespread. The World Book Encyclopedia, Vol. 11, p. 5125 states that "The greatest land boom in the history of Mississippi came after the treaties of 1830 and 1832 which opened for white settlement the last of the Indian lands in the region. By 1837 most of these lands had been taken up by private owners. So many settlers from the East came to claim the cheap, fertile land that this migration has been compared with the gold rush to California in 1849."

Wesley A. and Frances Anderson were in Choctaw Co., MS by 1837 when their son, Francis M. was born. They lived there until about 1844. Their last child, Penina was born in Alabama in 1845. The 1850 census shows them in Randolph Co, Alabama with eight children still at home.

Wesley died May 5, 1855 in Randolph Co. Nothing more is known about Frances until her death, July 6, 1902. Possibly she lived with a married daughter whose married name is not known at this time. The 1900 census would give us valuable information about her if she could be located.

Wesley A. and Frances Anderson's son, John Priar, is our next ancestor in the line of descent. He was born Dec. 17, 1826 in Georgia--possibly in Talbot Co. On Jan. 18, 1849, he married Martha Malysa Fincher, daughter of Thomas Fincher and Lucinda McClendon. Thomas Fincher was the son of Benjamin and Jemima Fincher. Lucinda McClendon, born June 26, 1830 in GA was probably the dau. of Thomas McClendon and Elizabeth Calloway of Henry County, GA, but no proof has been found. Thomas Fincher m. Lucinda McClendon in Jasper Co., GA Sept. 4, 1823. After Thomas' death, Lucinda married Zachariah Darden. She died about 1887 and is buried in Zion Baptist Church Cemetery, Woodland, Alabama in Randolph County.

John Priar and Martha M. Anderson lived in Randolph Co. until after 1880. The 1900 census shows them in Lost Creek, Cleburne County, just north of Randolph County. He was a Baptist minister—the hellfire and brimstone kind, it is said. Also, it is said that John Priar fell off his horse dead riding home from church one Sunday at noon.

Thomas Wesley Anderson was born June 7, 1852 in Randolph Co., AL to John P. and Martha M. Anderson. He married Lovina Washington ca. 1871. She was the daughter of Martin Washington and Elizabeth Hopkins. About 1892 or 1893, they came to Texas and settled in Bell County. They stayed about two years and went back to Alabama for a few years before returning to Texas again after 1900.

Thomas W. bought land east of the Weidel Cemetery in a community called Lee. Later, Lee and Grindale consolidated their schools and called it Leedale. Thomas W. was a very conservative man and made money off the land. He accumulated enough land for each of his children to have a farm. One grandson, Elmer Sikes, recalled his grandfather coming over to their house one time and he had bailing wire for a belt and twine for shoe laces!! He didn't believe in wasting anything. His son, William Jesse, was my grandfather.

TX, Brown Co, TX, Runnels Co., TX and Wilbarger Co. TX.

There are two Thomas Sadler wills in Brunswick C. Va, one dated 1793 of the Thomas Sadler who married Martha Rose. The other is dated 1796. Is there a connection between these Thomas Sadler men?

We also find a Peterson G. Sadler in Ga. In Putnam Co. in 1842 his administrator was Dr. Charles Wesley Sadler, a son of Nathaniel Milton Sadler I. We need information on him and feel that he is a relative since the name "Peterson" has been passed down through the family.

We need information on Geraldine Sadler and Monroe Dupre and their descendants. They married in Anderson Co., TX.

We need information on her half sister, Cora Diggs, who married Dr. D. Brom McGee.

In 1713 in Henrico Co., Va., a Thomas Sadler bequeathed his children to Elizabeth Coghill who a year later was Elizabeth Jones. The children were Thomas, Mary and Sarah. Need information on these people.
