LIST OF COMPANIES THAT ENGAGED IN THE  
STORMING OF BEXAR, 5-10 December 1835

Part 3, Second Division

Explanatory introduction may be seen in the June-November 1981 and March 1982 issues of AGS Quarterly. For the following companies in the Second Division, we have no muster rolls, only the Detailed Report, on which the volunteers are numbered consecutively after #1 James G. Swisher, captain. Rank is not always indicated on the report; the names have been rearranged in alphabetical order but the numbers retained so the reader can judge if their relative positions had any significance when the list was compiled [e.g., was #3 a lieutenant or sergeant?].

"Detailed Report of Names of those persons who Volunteered and formed the Second Division in the attack on San Antonio de Bexar and entered the house of Berramender\* on the night of the 5th of Decr 1835 under Command of Col. F.M. Johnston\*\* assisted by Cols. J. Grant & W.T. Austin, adjt. N.R. Brister & Dr. Jno. Cameron."

\*The then-deceased Juan Martin Veramendi (father-in-law of James Bowie) had been first alcalde of Bexar and was governor of Coahuila y Tejas 1832-33. His San Antonio home was known as the Veramendi Palace.

[This shows one cannot trust the wording in these records: he died 14 Nov 1862, so it must have been patented to his heirs in 1911--Ed.]

8. Darr, Geo. - Don Cert - 640 a - 28 Jan 1840 - Siege of Bexar - 640 a Nueces Cty ptd to him 5 Jan 1849. ... Bty Wnt - 1280 a 13 Aug 1849 - serv 14 Jan to 18 May 1836 [appears to be too much-- must include service in Dec 1835] - 1280 a Erath Cty ptd to him 5 Nov 1849.

11. Davis, Hiram - Hiram E. - Don Cert - 640 a - 22 May 1838 - Siege of Bexar - 640 a McLennan Cty ptd to him 5 Nov 1845. ... H.E. - Bty Wnt - 320 a - 7 Jly 1853 - serv 5-10 Dec 1835 - 320 a Montgomery Cty surveyed but not ptd - wnt rejected by Court of Claims 9 Aug 1860. [He had recd a Bty Wnt 10 May 1838 for serv 8 Oct to 22 Dec 1835, of which he ptd 156 a Anderson Cty 30 Aug 1866; 82 a same on 28 Jly 1887; 65 a same on 30 Aug 1866.]

5. Davis, Lee - Lee R. - Don Cert - 640 a - 7 Aug 1838 - Siege of Bexar - 640 a Bosque Cty ptd to him 2 Dec 1847. ... Bty Wnt - 320 a - 25 Apr 1838 - serv 21 Nov 1835 to 21 Jan 1836 - 320 a Hill Cty ptd to asgn in 1847.

13. Isaacs, Wm. - William - Don Cert - 640 a - 9 June 1838 - Siege of Bexar - 640 a Milam Cty ptd to him 25 Jan 1841. ... Bty Wnt 1280 a - 15 Jan 1838 - serv 23 Sep 1836 to 23 Sep 1837 [1835-36?] - 1280 a Coryell Cty ptd to him 9 Feb 1846.

6. Lassassair, Alert - Lesassier, A. - Bty Wnt - 320 a - 9 June 1838 - serv 20 Jly to 20 Nov 1836 - 320 a Kimble Cty ptd to asgn in 1849.

12. Lynch, Joseph P. - Don Cert - 640 a - 23 May 1838 - Siege of Bexar - 566 a Freestone Cty ptd to him 11 Feb 1851, bal to asgn in 1855. ... Bty Wnt - 320 a - 10 May 1838 - serv 21 Oct to 22 Dec 1835 - 320 a Bell Cty surveyed but not ptd.

15. Outlaw, N.B. - L.B. - Don Cert - 640 a - 2 Sep 1854 - Siege of Bexar - 3 tracts Ellis Cty ptd to him 19 Aug 1861, 29 Jan & 14 Apr 1868; 134 a Mills Cty "ptd to him" 23 Oct 1931. ... Bty Wnt 320 a - 14 Jan 1841 - serv 4 Nov to 13 Dec 1835 - ptd to asgn 1847.

4. Rainey, Clement - Clemant - Don Cert - 640 a - 4 Dec 1838 Battle of San Jacinto - 640 a Johnson Cty ptd to him 1 Jly 1859. ... Clement - Bty Wnt - 640 a - 19 May 1838 - serv 8 Sep 1835 to 1 June 1836 - 640 a Falls Cty ptd to him 9 Feb 1846.

3. Saul, T.S. - Apparently did not apply for land. Handbook of Texas says he joined Texas Army at Gonzales; on 8 Oct 1835 was elected orderly sergeant for the Washington company, and served under James G. Swisher in Siege of Bexar.

7. Wells, Fleming T. (?) - no record found.

31. Despalier, B.P. - B.P. Despallier rcd Don Cert - 640 a - 7 Oct 1852 - Siege of Bexar - ptd to asgn in 1853. ... Bty Wnt - 320 a - 7 Oct 1852 - for "storming of Bexar" - 320 a Jackson Cty ptd to him 1 Jly 1858.

27. Nelson, Edward - (Heirs) Bty Wnt - 1920 a - 1 Mch 1839 - for his service 1 Jan to 6 Mch 1836 & having fallen at the Alamo - no reference to Siege of Bexar.

24. Roberts, Thos H. - (Heirs) Bty Wnt - 1920 a - 16 Apr 1855 for service from 13 Jan 1836 & having been killed in the service. "Land Office Muster Roll, p. 68, shows Thomas H. Roberts joined Capt. Chenowith's Company on 13 Jan 1836."

6 Dec 1857 because "original grantee's name does not appear on the  
Muster Rolls & the assignment believed to be fraudulent."

1838 - Siege of Bexar - 640 a ptd to asgn in 1855. ... Bty Wnt -  
320 a - 7 Dec 1838 - serv 6 Oct 1835 to 6 Jan 1836 - 320 a ptd to  
asgn in 1853.  
47. Curtis, James - James Curtis Jr. & Sr. rcd Bty Wnts but  
neither one is cited for service in December 1835.

Smith - Don Cert - 640 a - 29 Jan 1855 - Siege of Bexar - 640 a Newton Cty surveyed but not ptd. ... No Bty Wnt for 1835 service. ... John W. 148. Barbo, J.J. - Juan J. E. [E. Barbo = Ybarbo] - Don Cert - 640 a - 27 "May" 1854 - Siege of Bexar - 640 a Montague Cty surveyed for him but not ptd. ... Bty Wnt - 320 a - 27 "Mar" 1854 - serv 11 Nov to 15 Dec 1835, incl Siege of Bexar - wnt rejected by Court of Claims in 1860. AND/OR: Juan Jose Y. Barbo [Ybarbo] - Don Cert - 640 a - 5 Aug 1854 - Siege of Bexar - 640 a Montague Cty surveyed but not ptd as cert was suspended by Court of Claims 19 May 1858. ... Bty Wnt - 320 a - 3 Aug 1854 - serv in Siege of Bexar - 640 a located by asgns but wnt rejected by CC in 1860.

142. Blair, John - Heirs of - Don Cert - 640 a - 22 Dec 1853 for his having fallen in the Alamo - land ptd Falls Cty in 1858. ... Bty Wnt - 1920 a - 16 Feb 1852 - serv 12 Oct 1835 until his death at Alamo 6 Mch 1836. Land ptd Anderson Cty 1854-55.

144. Brookfield, Chas - William C. - Don Cert - 640 a - 16 Dec 1854 - Siege of Bexar - Cert approved 1859 but no survey made. ... Bty Wnt - 320 a - 4 Nov 1841 - serv 16 Nov to 11 Dec 1835 in Siege of Bexar - ptd to asgn in 1848.

150. Burns, John - No John, but Squire Burns rcd Don Cert 640 a - 30 May 1838 - Siege of Bexar - 640 a Goliad Cty ptd to him 27 Jan 1841. ... Bty Wnt - 320 a - 30 May 1838 - serv 28 Sep to 13 Dec 1835 - 320 a Goliad Cty ptd to him 27 Feb 1841.

141. Carter, James - Lt. - Don Cert - 640 a - 15 Oct 1839 - Siege of Bexar - 640 a ptd to asgn in 1857. ... Bty Wnt - 320 a - 15 Oct 1839 - serv 20 Nov to 14 Dec 1835 incl Siege of Bexar - 320 a Nacogdoches Cty ptd to him 19 Aug 1859.

162. DeWitt, J.M. - Only James C. found--no 1835 service.

149. Fitz, Jabez - J. Fitch - Don Cert - 640 a - 1 Feb 1853 - Siege of Bexar - 2 surveys in Cass Cty made on Cert but not ptd be-

cause forfeited for non-return of Cert by 29 Jly 1872. ... Bty Wnt - 320 a - 1 Feb 1853 - serv 16 Nov to 15 Dec 1835 - 320 a Cass Cty surveyed but not ptd because Wnt rejected by CC 11 Nov 1858. - Jabes Fitch also rcd Bty Wnt for serv 17 Dec 1835 to 26 Apr 1836; that Wnt also rejected.

150. Goff, Henry - Bty Wnt - 320 a - 17 Jan 1838 - serv 12 Apr to 12 Jly 1836 - ptd to asgn 1858. ... Henry Gough - Bty Wnt - 320 a - 29 Feb 1848 - serv 6 Oct 1835 to 4 Jan 1836 - ptd to asgns in 1849 and 1851.

157. Hafner, John - no similar name found.

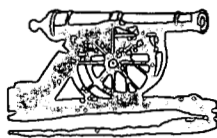

## Book Review

GREGG COUNTY TEXAS MARRIAGE LICENSE INDEX by Nancy Blakeley Ruff, c 1980. 8½ x 11"; typewritten; unnumbered pages; \$12.50 from compiler at 13 Iris Circle, Longview TX 75601.

Gregg County Texas Marriage License Index, Books A, B, C and D, 1873-1895, is a neatly typed and well arranged compilation. The first half lists the grooms first (in alphabetical order) and the second is alphabetized by the brides' surnames. It is advisable to examine both, for sometimes the spelling varies. Both sections give date of issuance of license and book and page references. Occasionally there is no "Miss" or "Mrs." before the bride's name, which I first thought might indicate that they were black, but others of the same surname had a title, so my investigation of this variant was inconclusive.

The indexing is of the annoying "first two letters only" type, but in the male section at least there is a key to show where it changes from Be to Bi, for example. But the reader is cautioned that "Names are out of place in many instances," so one really needs to examine all the A's, etc.

Helpful is a page headed "Tips on Gregg County Research." Mrs. Ruff suggests requesting certified copies of marriage licenses (\$2) or birth or death records (\$3) from the office of the County Clerk at Longview TX 75601.

Gregg County was formed from Upshur and Rusk counties in 1873. Those who had ancestors in that area and era will welcome this attractive addition to the shelves of Texas State Library.

THE BLAKELEY FAMILY JOURNAL edited by Nancy Blakeley Ruff, 13 Iris Circle, Longview TX 75601; \$10 for four quarterlies.

The heading of this Journal states that it includes all spellings: Blakely, Blakley, Bleakley. In the sample furnished (Volume II No. 1, Summer 1981) there are queries pertaining to Blakeney, Blakeslee, Blakey, Blaky, Blaikley and even Blackley and Blackler.

The contents consist of charts and reprints of material pertaining to these names, apparently most of them furnished by subscribers. There is no mention of an index (perhaps there is an annual one), nor is there a cover on the copy submitted for review.

Blakeley researchers should find this quarterly an interesting and sometimes profitable resource. The publications of a "one-name" society are always the richest ground into which to plant a query concerning one's own ancestors of that name.

## EDITOR'S COMMENTS

Since our Mexican War soldiers' records series was suspended for lack of space in the last issue of AGS Quarterly, I decided to extend the hiatus (a bugaboo among librarians and archivists!) through this number in order to conclude the "Storming of Bexar" series. I hope to complete the "Early Church Fathers--and Mothers" listing in the September issue also.

Ancestor Listing Cards. In order to promote exchange of information among those who are searching for the same families, Clarice Neal and Barbara Goudreau have set up files in the Genealogy Section of Texas State Library. They will be happy to sell you as many cards as you like (@ 5¢) to fill out and return for filing. The cards have spaces for Surname & First Name; dates & places of Birth, Death and Marriage; Name of Spouse; Children; Parents. A line to indicate what you most need is above the Name & Address of the Searcher, followed by Date and advice to Use Reverse for Additional Comments.

Next time you are at the Library also ask to see the geographical location file. Both files are extremely beneficial. These cards can be of great value to researchers, especially those from out of town who do not have an opportunity to compare notes with us at the meetings of Austin Genealogical Society.

Ancestor Listing Pages. It is delightful to see how many different forms our imaginative members have sent in for this issue. Almost any little thing you want to "get in print," perhaps to photocopy and send to relatives (for we are not so selfish as to copyright our quarterly) is acceptable for our June issue each year.

BASIC RESTRICTIONS: that the material is not already copyrighted; that it is legible (Some of you need darker typewriter ribbons); that margins are such that your first page is a left-hand page and your second is on the right, so that they face each other; that your pages are sent to 2202 W. 10, Austin 78703 by the 10th of May; AND that your dues were sent to the Treasurer (not the Editor) by MAY DAY. A single membership gives you two pages (NOT two sheets on both sides) and a double membership entitles y'all to four pages.

Queries and feature stories are welcome for any other issue, but they are subject to editing. This old proofreader cannot resist correcting misspelled words and grammatical errors, while dates like 3/4/36 or 29 Feb 1857 make my hair stand on end!

It is advisable to distinguish between middle and maiden names for married women--the latter can be put in parentheses. [Elizabeth Harwood Hoskins became Elizabeth (Hoskins) Purvis.] On charts, show women by their maiden names only so it won't look as if they all married their paternal cousins, as Eleanor (Roosevelt) Roosevelt did!

LETTERS FROM JAMES MATT McCLURE

James Matt McClure was born 13 Mch 1830 in Fayette County, Tennessee. By October 1839 he was living in Fayette County, Texas, with his parents, Asa and Susana (Archer) McClure, and his younger siblings. One of these was Ada Alice McClure, who became the great-grandmother of AGS member Ellen Seals.

After attending the Asylum for the Deaf and Dumb in Austin for some years, James lived in Plum, Fayette Co, TX, with Morgan cousins. He was famous for the ox yokes he made, as well as tables and other furniture. He died around 1909-10, unmarried.

The 1860 census of Travis County shows him as J.M. McClure, age 32, D&D, student in the Asylum for Deaf & Dumb, at Austin.

Copies of the following poignant letters were sent to Ellen Seals by Mrs. Elizabeth K. Haggerton of Vinita OK. They give us an interesting glimpse of life in a state institution in those days.

Austin, Texas, Nov. 10th, 1857

Dear sister,

I received a letter from you last August. I loved to read this letter. I am glad to inform you that I am very well. I was glad to hear that F. McClure was married to a lady. I do not know her. You tell him he must write a letter to me. I give love to my sisters. There are eleven pupils in this institution. I am happy to be in the school. I have not been sick in nine months. B.F. Darby is not happy in school. He will be home in two or three weeks. I told F. Darby not to go home. He wishes to go home. He will be glad to work on his farm. I saw a little child ride in a wagon. A large dog drew the wagon in the city. I did not eat any peaches last summer. I will perhaps go home next June.

You must write a letter to me soon.

My Dear Sister E McClure

I take my pen in hand to write a letter to you. I received two kind letters. I was very fond of reading the letters. I read them several times. I frequently think of you when I sleep. I am in good health and hope you are in the same blessing. I hope to see you next July. I will be very happy to meet you. I enjoyed myself last Christmas. Prof. Van Nostrand gave us cornucopias and fire crackers. He is good and kind to us. I have not heard from Philip McClure a long time. I will try to write to him next time. I am learning Mitchell's Primary Geography. There are fifteen boys and nine girls in this Institution. We are all well. You must write to me as soon as you can.

In the 1872-73 Austin City Directory, Mrs. Jane McClure resided at the northwest corner of Cypress [3rd] and San Antonio, while Mrs. Mary E. McClure had a grocery on Congress between Hickory [8th] and Bois d'Arc [7th] streets. Their relationship to James, if any, is not known.

#### WILL OF HARRY DOUGLAS McCLURE

In her research, Ellen Seals found a will in the Travis County Clerk's office that would bring joy to the heart of a descendant, but unfortunately the testator does not seem to connect with her line. She shares this brief abstract:

Harry Douglas McClure was a son of Jas. Douglas McClure, deceased, who was a son of Wm. McClure, deceased, late of the County of ---, Ireland.

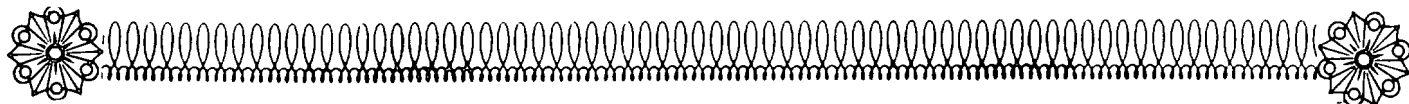
Nephew of Miss Anna McClure, deceased.

#### A BASTROP COUNTY BURYING GROUND

Ms. Marcella Chapple of 1402 Wooten Drive, Austin 78758, has submitted an interesting item pertaining to the burial of a Roe family and others. There are no markers, but the following explanation is made:

"Take Notice - To whom this may concern -- This is the names of the people that are buried in the old F.M. Roe cemetary - on the F.M. Roe Farm - about 4 miles South of Paige. Farm now\* owned by the family of W.O. Lindner (deceased). This was reported to me - Wesley McPhaul on June 22 - 1921 A.D. by Mrs. Mollie Roe Yarbrough, daughter of F.M. Roe.

## ANCESTOR LISTINGS OF MARY C. FORISTER

ROBERTSON. In an old Bible is written "James H. Robertson \$100 1854." He may have been father of William Frank Robertson b. 18 Mch 1830 in TN. The 1880 & 1900 censuses show that William and his father were born in TN. But an obituary states that William was born in Missouri...came to Texas as a babe with parents who later returned to MO...when he was 16 (1846) he came to TX alone on horseback...settled first at Manor [Travis Co] but in 1851 moved to Lockhart, Caldwell Co; in 1872 moved to Lytton Springs community.

I have a picture marked "J.L. Robertson and his family [around 1914] from Lutesville [Bollinger Co], Missouri." That could have been Jesse L. Robertson; he and son Leroy were manager and lineman of a telephone company in 1900. Was Jesse a brother of Wm. Frank?

CAPERTON\_DENSON\_ESTILL\_HUDSON\_SCRIBNER/SCRIVNER. Andrew Caperton (b. ca 1814) m. Jane T. Scribner, dau of Reuben & Mary Ann (Estill) Scrivner--need all dates. In mid 1850's, Andrew & Jane came to Texas from Holmes Co, MS, with daughters Mary Ann, Lucy S., Sallie Jane & Amanda Rebecca. Andrew died (in Travis Co?) around 1856; Jane remarried (18 Jan 1860) James H. Denson in Travis Co. Andrew, Jane & James possibly buried in Bluff Springs, Travis Co.

Lucy S. Caperton m. Marion M. Hudson 25 Dec 1866 in Caldwell Co TX. He fought in Civil War; in 1866 was sheriff of Caldwell Co; died ca 1887. Was he buried in Caldwell, Hays or Travis Co, TX?

DRANE\_MALTBY\_TABOR. Belle Maltby was born 14 Sep 1848 (in Arkansas?) & died 1 Feb 1870 in Bryan, Brazos Co, TX. Was she sister of Capt. William "Jeff" Maltby who fought in Civil War & was an Indian fighter? His book & obituary do not mention brother or sister. ... In courthouse in Bryan I found a name that looks like "R.S. Maltby"; could it be Belle's father?

Around 1867 Belle m. William H. Tabor (b. 1845, Winston Co, MS, son of John Washington Tabor & wife). He & his father fought in Civil War, John being a major; later was mayor of Bryan. Belle and William had one daughter, Martha Pearl. After Belle died, William m. Elizabeth Drane & had son, William Jefferson Tabor. The elder William died in 1875 or 1885; buried in Drane Family Cemetery at Bankston (Seymore Farm), Choctaw Co, MS. Need dates.

At Barker Library in Austin a card from the Newspaper Collection catalog reads: "William TABOR, Shooting Affair, 2 July 1872, Daily Telegraph, Houston, page 4, column 3." However, that issue was missing. Shooting may have occurred at Bryan--can anyone give me the details?

HENRY\_REYNOLDS\_TABOR. Mariah Henry, dau of John & Mary (Reynolds) Henry Sr., was born 10 May 1801 (Bibb Co, AL?) and died on 13 Feb 1884 in Bryan, Brazos Co, TX. Mariah m. Judge Nathan Tabor who died 5 Dec 1869 in Mississippi. Did she come to Texas soon after that to be with her son, Major John W. Tabor? Would like to have complete dates and confirmation of tradition that John Henry was a cousin of Patrick Henry of Virginia.

ALLEN\_CLARK(E)\_FORRESTER\_McADA\_PEELE\_QUARLES. Isabella McAda b. 29 Apr 1802 (AL?), d. 5 Jan 1830 (?), m. 2 Oct 1821 Harding Forrester (Need names & dates of his parents, etc.). Three Forrester children: (a) Mary J. b. 29 Oct 1823, m. 13 Jan 1840 Lewis Allen; (b) Nancy E. b. 3 Mch 1826, m. 20 Aug 1841 Thomas C. Clark/Clarke (Both these marriages in Shelby Co, TN); and (c) John Hardin b. 5 Dec 1829, m. 26 Jly 1855 Mary Elizabeth Peeler in Fayette Co, TX. ... After Isabella died, Harding m. Catherine Quarles on 3 Jly 1835 in Shelby Co, TN. Seeking more information on Allen, Clark(e) and Quarles.

CADWELL\_FORRESTER\_PEELE. Mary Elizabeth Peeler (wife of John Hardin Forrester) was born 10 Jan 1838 near Griggsville Landing on Illinois River (Pike Co, IL?) and died 13 Dec 1913 in Caldwell Co, TX. Daughter of Squire and Jane (Cadwell) Peeler who moved to Fayette Co, TX in 1850 with other children: Abner, John, Frederick, & Richmond. Squire died in 1851. Where in Fayette Co is Peeler Family Cemetery? Forresters had 5 sons--need data on them.

CROSS\_O'DANIEL. Mary Elizabeth R--- (Need parents' names etc) was born 19 Apr 1826 in AL; moved to MO where she m. Thomas S. Cross in 1843. Moved to TN; son Jasper (Jack) b. 1845; moved to Texas in 1853 & had two more children. Thomas Cross d. 1857; Mary Elizabeth m. Josiah Dial O'Daniel Sr. 4 Jly 1861 (Fayette Co, TX?)

# AHNENTAFEL

The word "ahnentafel" comes from two German words, "ahnen", meaning ancestors, and "tafel", meaning table, hence "table of ancestors". The same rules of numbering apply to this type of chart as in other commonly used genealogical charts. To find the father of any person listed, simply double his number. To find the mother, double the number, plus one. Missing numbers indicate unknown ancestors.

Unfinished Autobiography of Thomas Franklin Harwood,  
(1857-1929), an attorney of Gonzales, Texas

[Maternal grandfather of Mrs. H.H. Rugeley, 2202 W. 10, Austin 78703]

I was born at Gonzales Texas November 8th 1857--My birth place was the old house now known as the Geo W.L. Fly place on about Lots 5 & 5[sic] Tier No 1 East Avenue just East of the D.S.H. Darst property on East Avenue. While I was still an infant my father purchased and began to improve the West half of block 30 Inner Town of Gonzales upon which he resided until his death. My first recollection dates to the time during the Civil War. I remember the marching of soldiers, my mother's distress at the departure of my father and her brothers, the joy at my father's return on furlough from the war, and the anxiety, fears and hardships we endured during the war. Near the end of the war when about six years old I started to school in the building known as Gonzales College, now the residence of Wm. M. Atkinson [in 1962, Mrs. Henry Reese Jr.] to one Mr. Macumber and remained a few months, and then I attended school a short time in a small brick house which stood upon the lot upon which is now the residence of Mrs. James W. Bailey. My teacher was Miss Luxina Collins (afterwards the wife of Felix G. Smith and mother of Sidney [and Bes-sie] Smith). I then returned to school at the "College," as it was called, H.M. Allis principal. My first teacher there was the Rev. Buckner Harris, a Methodist preacher. My classmates and chums at school were Robert H. Walker, Frank Atwood Brooks, James Bissett, I.G. Jones, Charles A. Burchard, Ben N. Peck, Tom Anderson, Joe Thomas, Mollie Monroe, Ada Lewis, Blanche Aycock, and others. I continued at this school a while, one or two years, until my Aunt Lucy Harwood began teaching school in a small house on Block 28 now owned by me, and I attended school there several years and on the place where my brother A.R. Harwood now resides. On the latter place she taught with Mr. P.P. Price. It was about this time I began to study in earnest. I also began the study of Latin under Thomas J. Pilgrim, receiving lessons from him at his residence daily. And soon afterwards I began the study of German under the tutelage of Mrs. Fautts, the wife of John Fautts, which I pursued for several years. Afterwards I returned to the "College," and studied under "Miss Frank" McClure (afterwards Mrs. H.M. Allis) and under H.M. Allis himself. I was also a pupil of Mr. A.O. Brooks for several years and began the study of Greek under him. None of these schools were well conducted or thorough and when I afterwards went to College I realized that I had been badly taught in most of the branches.

In June 1873, when 15 years of age, my father, mother, Aunt Lucy and all my brothers and sisters started on a trip to Virginia, his old home. A short time previously, the R.R. connection had been made at Denison between the Houston & Texas Central R.R. and the M.K.T. R.R., thus permitting an all rail trip to the North & East. Our route was by carriage and hack to Columbus, Texas, the then terminus west of the G.H. & S.A. Rwy, where we bought tickets to Houston. Thence we went by the H. & T.C. R.R. to Denison, Texas, & thence over the M.K. & T. R.R. to St. Louis. Thence by the B. & O. to Washington, D.C. Here we spent several days and I saw for the first time a city, the Nation's Capitol and the great Departments. From here we went to Richmond where we remained at Fords Hotel a day or

two and then went by rail to Sweet Hall & then to Newington, the family seat of the Harwoods in King & Queen County.

We spent the summer here and I made the acquaintance of my Virginia kin. In August the family returned home and I was left with my uncle Samuel F. Harwood and his wife Aunt Betty. I became a favorite of my uncle and his wife and was greatly benefitted by association with them. My Cousin Mattie Bird and Aunt Kate and my Aunt Emily were very kind to me. At the end of August we went to Richmond and stopped at the home of Dr. John R. Garnett, my father's half-uncle, and my Uncle Sam purchased for me my clothing, and about September 1st he took me to Hampden-Sidney College.

We were invited to the home of Dr. J.M.P. Atkinson, President of the College (the session had not opened) and I remained there a day or two and then went to board with Mrs. Virginia Hage [Hoge?], the widow of Dr. Wm. Hage who was a brother of Dr. Moses Hage of Richmond. Mrs. Hage was Virginia Harrison, one of the proud aristocratic families of that name who lived on James River, but had been ruined by the war. She was a woman of refinement, education and travel and was very bright, but was proud and egotistical and not very popular on the "Hill." Her step-son Addison was professor of Greek at Hampden-Sidney and she resided with him in the residence assigned him, the Lampson house in a grove East of the church. She had two children: Miss Nannie, a young lady who afterwards married a missionary to Brazil, and Peyton Hage, a son about my age but who was then in the Sophomore class. Peyton was a very talented boy and stood at the head of his class but was very conceited and greatly resembled his mother. I roomed with him and Tom Ballard Preston of Blacksburg, Virginia. There were two other boarders: Charles Giese of Baltimore and Allen Hall of Georgia. I formed no attachment for them--none of them were of much force. There were also three day boarders: Wm. Lefevre, R.K. Moseley, and another who were divinity students at the Seminary.

I found considerable difficulty in getting into the Freshman Class on account of my poor preparation and miserable training.... However, I passed my intermediate [?] examinations and went to Newington to spend the Christmas Holidays. At Hampden-Sidney there was much rivalry between the Union and Philanthropic Literary Societies and the various Fraternities which made cliques among the students. Among the early acquaintances I made at College was Charles W. Dabney, son of Dr. Robt. Dabney, the foremost divine in the Presbyterian Church & Prof of Theology at Union Seminary. He had rented his home to the widow of James Garnett, a relative of my father's. Charles took me to see Mrs. Garnett and was very kind to me. He was afterwards Asst. Secty. of Agriculture; now Prof. of A&M College of Tennessee. I also became acquainted with Saml Dabney (now a lawyer of Victoria) and Louis Dabney of Dallas (his younger brothers).

I joined the Philanthropic Society and Beta Theta Pi fraternity and took an active part in both. I did only moderately well in my studies owing largely to the poor preparation I had received before entering college. I passed my examinations, however, and made many friends among the students.

## LESLIE-HARRIS BIBLE RECORD

A query in the ULSTER GENEALOGICAL & HISTORICAL GUILD, regarding the families of Thomas and Jane Leslie and John and Mary Leslie, who came to South Carolina from Antrim, Ireland in 1765, brought a very interesting response from Jane Leslie Stone Latta (Mrs. John W. Jr.) of Arlington, Virginia. Excerpts from her letter to Harold Leslie Lemburg follow.

"Our Subscribers' Interest List #4 from the Ulster Genealogical and Historical Guild arrived a few days ago and I am quite interested in your entry concerning the Leslies. I am certain that your Leslies and mine are from the same tree."

"My ancestor--for whom I am named--was Jane Leslie, daughter of Thomas Leslie and Jane \_\_\_\_\_. She married John ('Flatwoods') Harris in Abbeville District, South Carolina on September 2, 1784. According to my information she was born in Antrim, Ireland (I do not know the date) and died in South Carolina on July 8, 1826. My information also says that Jane Leslie had a brother William and many years ago some member of this family had a letter that Jane Leslie Harris had written to her brother William Leslie about her conversion to religion."

"I am enclosing a typewritten transcript of the Harris Family BIBLE entries. I am the present owner of this BIBLE and I made the transcription. My husband has proof-read the entries and we feel certain they are accurate. The BIBLE is in no condition to xerox which is why I made the copy by typing. The handwritten page was written by my grandfather Charles Holmes Stone. His mother was a Harris-Jennie Leslie Harris, daughter of Thomas Alonzo Harris and Isabella Elizabeth Deas Walker. As you can see, T.A. Harris was the grandson of John Harris and his wife Jane Leslie."

"I have no idea who the Gastons were who are listed in the BIBLE entries nor do I know who was Julius H. Alexander. If you can shed some light on that I would be most grateful."

"A Mr. Carlisle in Calhoun Falls, S.C. <sup>11</sup> has told me about a Leslie graveyard in Abbeville County -- Do you know anything about that?"----

James Harris, son of John Harris and Grizzell Steel, married Elizabeth Harris, daughter of Colonel Robert Harris and Frances Cunningham.

John Harris, son of James and Elizabeth Harris, was born in Cabarrus County, North Carolina, married Jane Leslie daughter of Thomas and Jane Leslie, in Abbeville District, South Carolina September 2, 1784, Reverend Robert Hall officiating. He died in Abbeville District, South Carolina April 1, 1830. Jane Leslie died July 3, 1826.

This Scott Family Bible belonged to John Harris and was given to his grandson, T.A. Harris by him.

The Ann Harris whose birth Nov. 27, 1794 and marriage to James Wiley April 16, 1824 are recorded in this Bible, was the daughter of John and Jane Leslie Harris.

BURDETT. William Burdett was born in England in 1590 and came to Virginia in 1615. He married twice, both widows, Frances Saunders and Alice Travalier. His son Thomas was born by 1633 and married Verlinda Cotton on 1 Sept. 1658. Their daughter Sarah married Gerard Fowke, Jr. on 31 Dec. 1686. Which of William Burdett's two wives was the Mother of Thomas and what was her maiden name? When did Thomas die? When and where was Sarah born and when did she die?

CARDWELL. Thomas Cardwell, I was born in England ca 1614 and came to Virginia on the "Tristram & Jane" in 1636/37. In 1638 he married Mary and died in Henrico County in 1689. Thomas Cardwell, II was born in 1640, married 2nd. to Ann by 1686 and died in Henrico County after 1717. Thomas Cardwell, III was born in New Kent County in 1686, married to Martha Perrin and died in 1751. Their son John Cardwell married by 1760 Kesiah. Who was Mary the wife of Thomas I? Who was Ann the 2nd wife of Thomas, II? When did Thomas, III marry Martha Perrin? When was John born and who was Kesiah?

CLARK. Nancy Jane Clark was born in Georgia in 1820, married Lewis Newsome ca 1836 in Lafayette County, Miss. and died in Miss. in 1858. She was the daughter of John and Jenny Clark. Who were John and Jenny Clark and who were their parents? When and where were they born and when and where did they die?



FOX. John Fox was born in England in 1632 and he died in Virginia by 1683. His son Henry Fox (1650-1714) married Ann West, daughter of John West II and Unity Crowshaw. When did John Fox immigrate? Who was his wife?

HARRIS. Nathaniel Harris died in Prince William County, Virginia in 1718. He had three daughters one of whom, Ann Frances Harris, married Hoswon Hooe, SR. by 1724 and died in 1774. HOLMES. Edward Holmes married Elizabeth and died in Perquimans County, N.C. in 1702. His son John married Tamar Bird or Byrd and died in Edgecombe County, N.C. in 1736. HOOE. Rice Hooe I, was born in Wales in 1599 and immigrated to Virginia in 1618 on the "Giftie". He married after 1635 probably to Sarah Goodwin. Rice Hooe II was born in Virginia in 1640, married ca 1660 Susanna, the widow of Richard Nicholas. He died on 1 October 1694. Was Rice Hooe, Sr.'s wife Sarah Goodwin and where did they marry? Who was Susanna who married Rice Hooe II ?

JARRETT. Richard Jarrett was born in England, immigrated to Virginia by 1653 and died in Surry County in 1672. He married Margery who married after 1672 William Chambers. Their daughter Elizabeth Jarrett married William Gray in 1673. She died in 1719. When was Richard Jarrett born and when did he marry? Who was Margery? When was Elizabeth born and when did she die?

JENNINGS. Thomas Jennings was born in London England and immigrated to Virginia by 1634. He married by 1631 Dorothy Smith. Their son John Jennings married Martha Harris the daughter of Robert Harris. Robert Harris died in 1678/79 before he was banished from Virginia for supporting Francis Bacon in the rebellion. Their daughter, Mary Jane Jennings married by 1690 Edward Garland. When was Thomas Jennings born and when did he die? When was Dorothy Smith born and when did she die? When was John Jennings born and when did he marry? When was Mary Jane Jennings born and when did she die?

SPENCER. William Spencer was born in England ca 1582 and came to Jamestown on the "Susan Constant" in May 1607. He married Alice about 1619 and died ca 1637. Their daughter Elizabeth was born ca 1620 and married first Robert Sheppard. Who was Alice and when did she come to Virginia? When did Elizabeth marry and when did she die?

SMITH. John Smith (Everyone has to have a John Smith ancestor) was born in England married Margaret and died in 1669. Their daughter Margaret was born in 1658 and married John Vivion, Sr. in 1675. When was John Smith born and when did he immigrate? Who was Margaret and when and where was she born? If in England, when did she immigrate? If in Virginia, who were her parents?

FAAG. Peter Emil Faag was born in Copenhagen, Denmark in 1846. He was educated to succede his Father as the Pastor of his Church. However he got wanderlust and sailed as a midshipman on a Danish vessel. Sometime during the middle or late 1860s he jumped ship in New York where he obtained work as a clerk being able to speak and write several languages. Sometime between then and 1880 he came to Texas and became a teacher in small country schools ending in Fayette County, Texas where he married in 1886 Mary Weikel, a widow. About 1900 he moved to Houston Heights, Texas and lived there until his death in 1919. Any information about P. E. Faag or his parents would be appreciated. We are especially interested in just when he came to New York and his life between then and his marriage in 1886.

BRANDSTATTER. Alexander Brandstatter was born in Austria married there and came to Texas with his wife and family. They landed in Galveston in December 1855 and moved to Washington County, Texas and lived in the Berlin community abot 3 miles West of Brenham. His daughter Mary, born 1846, married Joseph Weikel, also from Austria, in 1863 and moved to Fayette County. After Joseph Weikel's death about 1884, Mary married Peter E. Faag. Who was Alexander Brandstatter's wife? From where in Austria did they come and when were they born and when did they die?

COGGIN. John Coggin, a physician, was born in England and married there Frances Bland, daughter of Gregory Bland. They came to Virginia ca 1654 with their daughter Rebecca. Rebecca married Francis Poythress II ca 1658. John Coggin died between 1666 and 1673 and Frances ca 1677. When were John, Frances and Rebecca born? Exactly when did John Coggin die and when did Rebecca Coggin Portyress die?

CROWSHAW. Raleigh Crowshaw was born in England and came to Virginia in 1608. He died in Jamestown in 1624. His son Joseph was born in Virginia ca 1619. Joseph married Margaret who died in 1665. Joseph died in York County on 10 April 1667. Their daughter Unity married Col. John West II in 1658. When was Raleigh born and who did he marry? Who was Margaret, Joseph's wife? DAINGERFIELD. John Daingerfield was born in England in the 1630s and came to Virginia with his Father, William Croshaw,\*\*in 1660. In 1670/71 he married Anne Walker, the widow of John Payne. Their son Edwin, born 1710 and 1715 married Mary Bassett in 1735. Their daughter Mary Bassett Daingerfield married Willam Starke. When did Edwin die in New Kent County? ENOCHS. John Enochs was born in Wales or Scotland in 1695, married Margaret Vanneman in 1739 and died in Rowan County, N.C. in 1765. His son Gabriel was born in Rowan County, N.C. in 1841 and served as a Colonel in the Revolution. When did John Enochs immigrate? Was he married to Margaret Vanneman, born in 1716, at that time or did he marry her in North Carolina? If they were married in North Carolina, who were Margaret's parents?

CROCKETT. James Edwin Crockett (1711- ? ) married Mary Wood on 3 July 1733 in Wirginia. Their son Walter Leake Crockett (1734- ? ) married on Dec. 9, 1753 Mary Ritchie or Richey. Who was Mary Wood? Who was Mary Ritchie? When and where did James and Walter die?

FENN. Cpt. Samuel Fenn came to Virginia in the "Tristram & Jane" in 1636/37 and married Dorothy. He died in 1660. Their daughter Sarah married before 1680 Thomas Claiborne and died in 1716. Who was Dorothy? Was Sarah married to Samuel Fenn before he immigrated? When was Sarah born and when did she die? When was Samuel Fenn born?

FIELD. Major Peter Field (1647-1707) married in 1678 Judith Soane, the widow of Henry Randolph. If Peter was born in England, when did he immigrate? If he was born in Virginia, where and who were his parents?

FOSSAKER. (Sometimes spelled Tassaker) Richard Fossaker I and his son Richard II were both born in England. Richard I died in Stafford County in 1676 and Richard II by 1715. Richard II married Sarah Withers by 1693 and their daughter Mary, born ca 1694, married Chandler Fowke ca 1716. When and where were Richard I and Richard II born? When did they immigrate? When and where was Sarah Withers born and where and when did she die? When did Mary Fossaker Fowke die?

HOBBS. William Hobbs was born 1787 in S.C. and died 17 Sept. 1837 in Alabama. He married 2nd in 1817 Polly Swinney the daughter of John Swinney and Liddy Polly. Who were the parents of William Hobbs? Who were the parents of John Swinney?

MAYFIELD. Abraham Mayfield was born in 1750 and died in Pendelton Dist. S.C. in 1827. He married 1770-76 Margaret (Peggy). Their granddaughter was Sabry Gebbert Mayfield, born 27 Sept. 1817 and died 16 June 1889 near Oxford, Miss. She married Jeel Washington Hobbs in 1839. Who were Abraham Mayfield's parents and who was Margaret? What was the source of the unusual name of Sabry that appears to be from the family name of some ancestor?

NEWSOME. William Newsome III, was born in Surry County, Virginia in 1672 and died in Surry County in 1751. He married Phyllis. When did he marry and who was Phyllis? Was Phyllis a Jordan?

PERRIN. Richard Perrin who died in 1695 married Katherine Royall in 1672. Their son Richard was born ca 1673, married ca 1693 Anne Porter and died in "enrico County in 1704. Was the first Richard an immigrant? He was when did he come to America? If he was born in America, who were his parents? Who was Anne Porter?

I'm trying to trace the George Byerly (Bierly, Byler, Byerley, Byley etc) family.

The name Byerly is spelled almost as many ways as I've found records.

In Amite County Mississippi records for 1830, the name is spelled BYERLY.

In 1835 or so, on the first census of Texas, the name is spelled BIERLY.

On a land certificate dated 1838 in Texas, the name is spelled BYERLEY.

On the 1840 Jasper County Texas Tax Roll, the name is spelled BYERLEY.

On the 1850 Walker County Texas Census, the BYERLY spelling is used.

On the 1860 Fayette County Texas Census you will find the name is spelled BYLER.

On a prisoner of war parol oath, dated July 1863, Stephen John, (my BYERLY branch) has signed his name as "Stephen John BYERLY!"

On the 1880 Fayette County Texas Census we find BYERLEY again.

A family from Jasper and now in Sabine County Tex. claim to be of the BYERLY family and they spell the name BYLEY.

I am very interested in hearing from anyone with any of the above spellings and any other spellings of the Byerly surname.

George Byerly was born in South Carolina, see the Walker County Texas 1850 census record. On the 1850 census his age is given as 55 years old, thus his birth year would be around 1795. He married Rebecca (Andrews ? Byrd ?) On the above mentioned census Rebecca was 34 years old. Her birth year would be around 1816 which would mean that George is somewhere around twenty years older than Rebecca. Rebecca was also born in South Carolina. Their first child, a son was Martin Byerly and he was 16 years old on the census mentioned above. Therefore his birth date or year would be around 1834 and place of birth is given as Mississippi. Where and when did George and Rebecca marry? Martin Byerly is the first child of which we have any record. Were there any children born else where? Before Martin?

Records of George Byerly in Texas was found in 1838 in the certificate for land in which he is proven to have been in Texas since 1st of March 1836. The 1840 Jasper County Tax roll show George paid tax on land. By 1850 George Byerly along with Rebecca was found in Walker County Texas Census. The names of their children and their ages given on the 1850 census are: Martin, age 16, born in Mississippi; William, age 14, born in Mississippi; Gabriel, age 13, born in Mississippi\* Steven, a twin, age 11, Nancy, his twin age 11, both born in Texas; Robert, age 8, born in Texas, James, age 7; Margery, age 5; and Sarah Ann, age 2, the last three born in Texas.

1836, \* Gabriel, above, if born in Mississippi was born early 1836, if the family was in Texas by March 1836.

DR. SAMUEL WILSON MONTGOMERY

Dr. ~~Montgomery~~ was one of the early practitioners in Van Zandt county and like many others of his day he was a native of Tennessee, born there on 23 Apr 1827 in the town of Ramer Station in Mc Nairy county. The town of Ramer was named after the father-in-law of his sister Mary, who married John Ramer. John and Mary Ramer had at least four sons, Roark, Thomas, Samuel, and Felix who later became a Doctor.

In addition to his sister Mary, Samuel had at least five brothers: James M., Marion, Roark, John M., Jeff and a second sister Margaret. James M. Montgomery also became a doctor and practiced in Smith county just across the county line in Jamestown. James was the father of George W., Agnes and Mary Elizabeth (Mollie) who later married Rufus B. Spears, an early settler of Van Zandt county. Mrs. M. J. (Maudie) Spears is still a resident of Grand Saline, Tx. Another brother John M. became a physician and practiced in Mississippi and Yell county Arkansas.

Samuel Wilson first married Malissa E. Strickland 9 Jan 1848. They lived in Tippah county Mississippi where he was a farmer. There is no record of any children and she apparently died early in their marriage. On 9 Sep 1857 Dr. Samuel married Caroline E. (Thomas) Ashford, born 30 Oct 1830 in N. C. They lived in Yalobusha County Miss. where Samuel was a Protestant Methodist Minister. They had two children Margaret and Morrison. Sometime in the early 1860's Samuel apparently went to Eclectic Medical school because



he was a part-time doctor in the Civil War. About 1867, after Caroline had died 17 Jul 1864, Dr. Montgomery and his two children Maggie and Morrison left Mississippi. They traveled by boat down the Mississippi river and back up the Red River to Jefferson, Tx. They then came to Grand Saline by train and wagon and settled nearby at Creagleville. On 25 May 1870 Dr. Montgomery married Lucinda (Bottoms) Mc Elroy. Lucinda was the ninth child of Zachariah Bottoms and Elizabeth Taylor and was born in Cherokee county Jan 1850. Lucinda and Samuel had at least nine children. Desda born 18 Jul 1871, died Sep 1873; son F. Marion born 17 Aug 1873, died 14 Aug 1955; dau. Maude born 1876/77; dau. Nora born 4 May 1880; son Robert Emmet born 12 Jan 1882, died 20 June 1957; dau. Sue born 31 Aug 1886, died 24 Aug 1919; one other daughter Bertha and two other sons, Wm Jefferson and James Lee. Maude married Joe Howard. Nora married Willie Lockhart. Sue married 1st Carl Mc Carter, 2nd John W. Gossett. Dr. Montgomery was on the Van Zandt county tax rolls for the 1870's and 1880's under the H. Creagle, J. J. Kuykendall, Joseph Cox and Wm. Daniel headrights. The Doctor and his family lived near the old Creagleville Cemetary where he and Lucinda as well as two children are buried. Lucinda died about 1889 and he died 16 Jan 1892, one day before his brother Dr. James M. Montgomery.

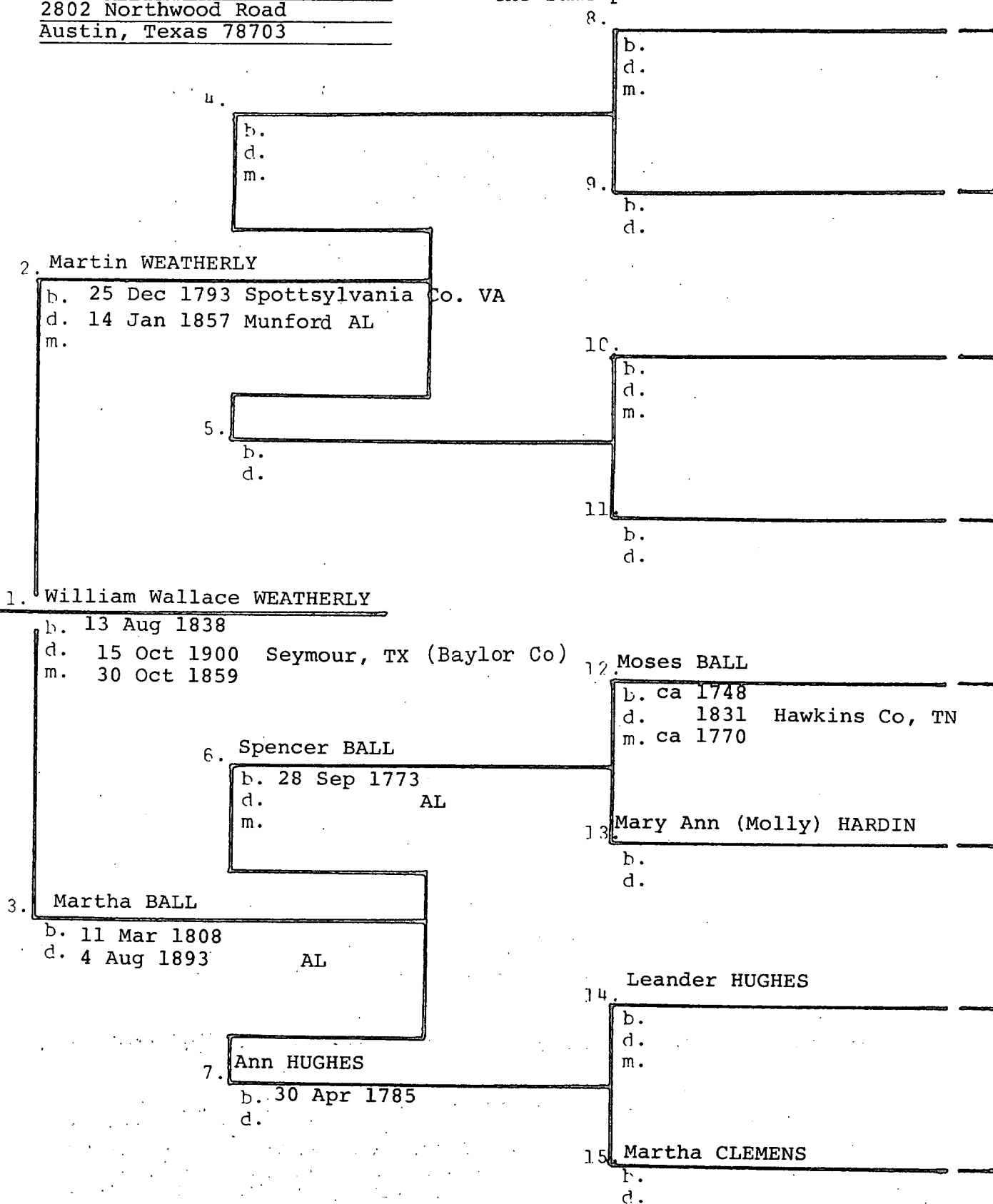

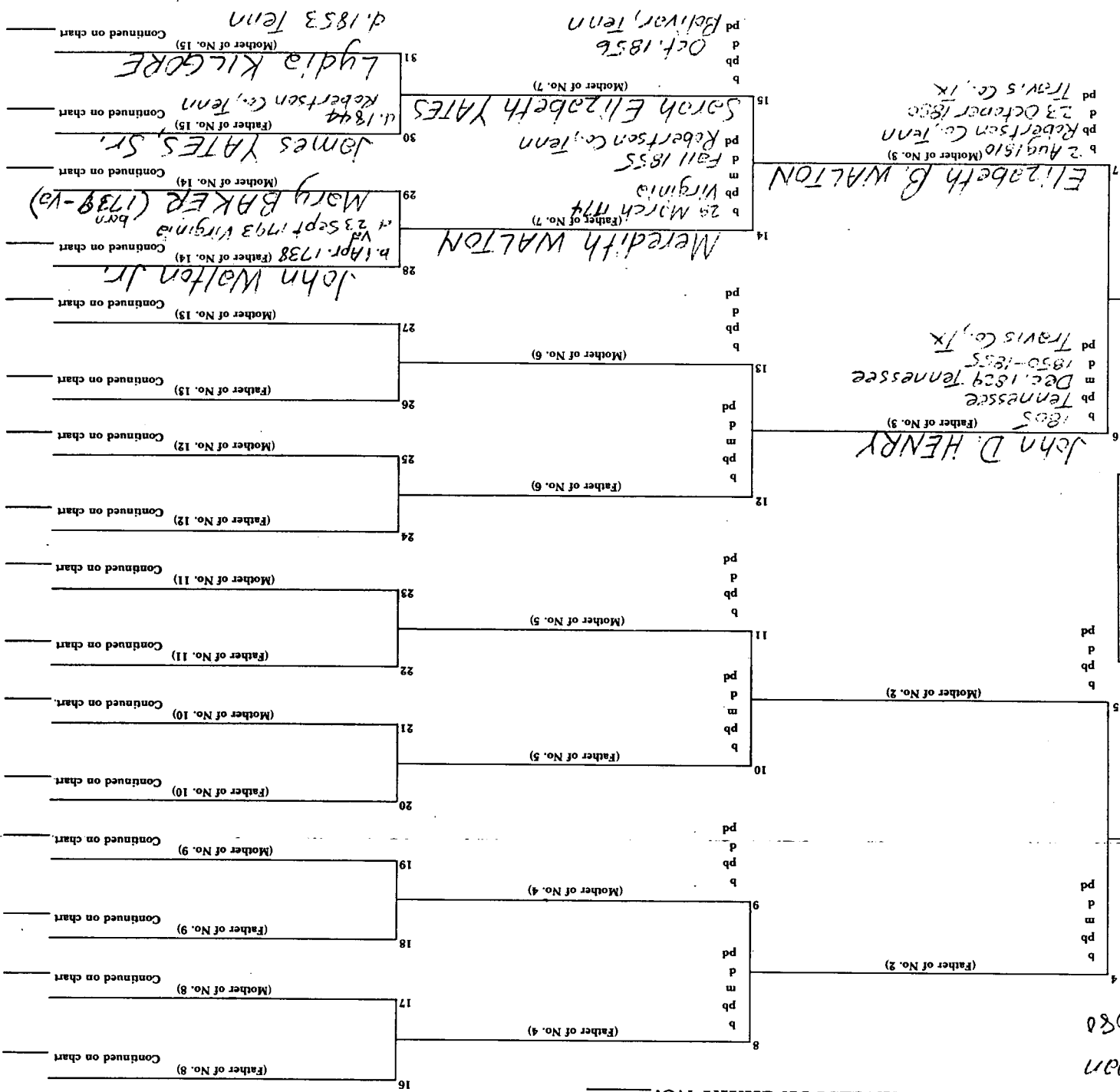
