Having found page on the census in Accelerated Index, the numbering of the visitations leads one to the entry in Mrs. Carpenter's transcription, to which I am indebted in some instances (where the microfilm is illegible), but which sometimes may be interpreted differently.

Book Reviews

INDEX TO THE ARCHIVES OF SPANISH WEST FLORIDA, 1782-1810. New Orleans: Polyanthos, 1975. Map; drawing; Introduction; 365+ pages.

Here is an index that is almost as interesting to read as the average book! Nearly fifty years ago the papers of the Spanish government of West Florida, District of Baton Rouge, were translated and typed--a monumental task, completed in 1937, by the force of the Survey of Federal Archives at Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

The original documents were then deposited in the Record Room of the 19th Judicial District Court, and transcriptions were placed in Louisiana State Museum Library at New Orleans, and other major libraries. But until the present index was published, use of the typescripts was a formidable undertaking.

The introduction to Index to the Archives of Spanish West Florida was written by Stanley Clisby Arthur who was State Supervisor of the Survey of Federal Archives in Louisiana when the 18-volume transcript was made. He composed a short history of the region during 1763-1810, concluding with an explanation of Volume XIX: It was later "found in the first two volumes of the acts of East Baton Rouge Parish many cases that dated from 1799 to 1816 which were outgrowths of litigations that began during the years this part of Louisiana was under Spanish domination." Therefore, they translated and transcribed those acts in order to show the outcomes of such lawsuits.

Each volume is indexed separately (no explanation of the supplement to the index of Vol. X is given), and the formats differ slightly. Some show de Aguilera under A and under D; some show such names under A only and some under D only, which places a double burden on the reader who is seeking such a name.

Also, the reader must be constantly alert, ready to translate a name from Spanish to French to Dutch to English--plus a phonetic approximation in any of these languages. He might find O'Quin as Aucoin or Ocoin; Kuykendall appears as Kirkendaule and Kirykuanall; O'Brien becomes Obrillon or Obreon.

The compilers helpfully pointed out many Creole spellings used in the documents (especially in early volumes) by quoting them in the Index, such as "Charp, Pablo" (Paul Sharp); "Colen, Henrique" & "Colon, Enrique" (Henry Collins); "Fits Patric, Juan" (John Fitzpatrick). But the searcher should use his imagination also; for example, the Index lists "Bishears, Frederick affidavit (Vishears)," but if I were looking for Frederick Brashears I'd examine that affidavit. Another flexible name: Ory/Ury/Urie. And "Cabahannour"--could that be Cavanaugh? or Copenhaur? [Not in this book, but recently I saw a man named for the Euphrates River in the U's--Uphratus, And when we had named telephone exchanges, one subscriber had to ask for assistance: she could not get Yukon by dialing UK!]

In this Index, Iberville may appear as "Eberville, Ybervil, Yberbible or Yberville"; Ireland becomes "Yrlanda"; Jones "Yons." Other amusing spellings: "Dabid Quenedi" (David Kennedy); "Germi Quel[s?]ey"

(Jeremy/Jeremiah Kelsey/Kelley); "Kintoque" (Kentucky). The Dutch name Garret(t) Rapalje shows up as Rapalye/Rappalye; Rapalfe, Farret; and was finally Gallicized to Rapalier.

Users of the Index would be well advised to look for every possible (and some impossible!) spelling of a name, such as Deval/Devalle/Duval/Duvall; Lailland/Laland/La Lande/Leland, etc. French women usually appear under their maiden names.

Kindly hints tell us that "Hagana" = Higgins; "Ferchel" = Fairchild; "Pequi" = Peggy; "Rackasee" = Racourci; "Bergel" = Virgil; "Croquer" = Crocker; "Barquier, Breton" = Barker, Briton; "Yrven" = Irving; "Santiago Meier" = James Mather; "Don Miguel Mayer" is the Spanish version of Dr. Michel Mahier. Finally (much as I hate to put an end to this fun!), though it's not a name, if you decide to examine the originals, you'll need to know: "juisqui" = whiskey!

Besides proper names, this Index includes such topics as Sales, Powers of Attorney (both parties named), Law Suits, Wills, Successions [administration of estates], Slave Donations and Sales, Names of Free Mulattoes, Justices of the Peace (often with their county of residence in the index)--all well cross-indexed.

Occasional errors in alphabetizing and spelling do not appreciably mar the book, but one could wish that directions had been given for obtaining copies of pages desired.

Most recent in a fine series of books pertaining to the records and history of Lafayette County, Mississippi which the Skipwith Society has published, Family Ties, Volume II, consists of letters written between the 1830s and the 1930s. Most were written by people who had migrated from the county or by faraway relatives to kin-folks who had settled in Lafayette County.

The letters range in nature from business letters to letters written home by Confederate soldiers, to love letters, to bereavement letters, to letters written back by emigres, predominantly homesick Texas colonists hoping to persuade relatives and friends to at least consider joining them.

Other Texas counties referred to are Bosque, Clay, Delta, Fannin, Gregg, Limestone, Montague, Polk, "Robinson" (Robertson), and Walker. Researchers who had pioneer ancestors in any of these places can consult the index for pertinent surnames.

Most of the letters are rich in genealogical details (some even include brief lineage charts), and many poignant stories are suggested by terse statements.

The letters are copied verbatim, using a script typeface which, although harder to read, makes them look more authentic. Fortunately for the usually hurried researcher, the well-done CLARIFICATION notes appear in conventional typewriter style.

Names and addresses of contributors are given, and correspondence with them is invited (accompanied by an SASE, of course).

The Publication Committee (Joan Bratton, Deward Grissom, Juanita Harwell and Lenora Moore) who collected and transcribed these interesting letters are to be highly commended. Like those of Maury County, Tennessee, the records of Lafayette County have been skillfully and thoroughly preserved for the future and made readily available for the present.

BEWARE OF INACCURACIES

It seems as if every other publication I have picked up lately contains at least one seriously misleading statement. Some are the kind that the experienced genealogist has learned to discount, but I feel it my duty to warn the neophyte in the "mysterie of genealogie." It is not my intention to embarrass the writers but to encourage them either to verify their statements before publishing them or to make it clear that they are to be taken "with a grain of salt."

For example, in a recent Hoosier publication the rambling reminiscences of an old-timer include the statement that Daniel Boone (1734-1820) discovered the Cumberland Gap. His biography in World Book Encyclopedia (1938 edition) gives 1767 as the date of "his first expedition into the wilds of Kentucky," and states that he led a party to that region eight years later. In the "History of Tennessee" booklet recently produced by the Tennessee Tourist Development agency the article on Cumberland Gap National Historic Park asserts: "..... in 1750 [when Boone was 16], Dr. Thomas Walker discovered Cumberland Gap. ...", and that after Judge Richard Henderson in 1775 purchased the Cherokee claim to 20,000,000 acres south of the Kentucky River, he engaged Daniel Boone to blaze a trail through Cumberland Gap which be-

came known as the Wilderness Road, prominent in migration patterns.

Anyone who is seriously concerned with the subject can check it out in dozens of Kentucky and Tennessee histories; the above statements are convincing to me.

Another jolt was received recently while reading a monograph concerning Texas counties that were "named for heroes of the War of 1812." Henry Knox (1750-1806) was listed as one; my first thought was that 1806 was a typographical error for 1816, but the encyclopedia confirms his death date--six years before the war started! On closer examination I found several others, all worthy patriots, but not necessarily "heroes of the War of 1812" as the title would lead one to expect.

Then there is my pet peeve--calling a book the 1840 census of Texas when it is really a tax roll of only some of the counties then in existence. It is an extremely valuable book, and we're all grateful to the compiler, but we expect at least the number in the family to be revealed by a "census."

Quoting an exaggerated claim as a fact, with no qualifying explanation of the source, can lead to utterly false statements propagated by someone who takes a ridiculous assertion seriously.

There is a book about early churches in Texas which I hailed with joy because it names a number of women. But, sad to relate, many typographical errors mar its credibility, especially the wrong century in dates, and the index not only omits some names but often misspells others.

The authors apparently made no effort to verify the claims made by their sources, but one would think that long acquaintance with Texas history would have made them suspicious of the assertion that "by 1845 there were four hundred thousand Negro Baptists in Texas."

That rang a bell like a fire alarm in my head (notoriously poor at figures), so I called AGS member Abigail (Curlee) Holbrook, the authority on Texas plantations, who informed me that 23,624 slaves were on the tax assessment rolls in 1845, and that the 1847 state census showed 38,753 blacks. Perhaps the originator of the 400,000 figure assumed that each of the almost 24,000 slaves in 1845 was the head of a household of about 17 persons, but that was not the case: more than just the fathers were taxed. Even adding the 102,000 - plus whites shown in 1847 does not nearly total 400,000 inhabitants in Texas at that time.

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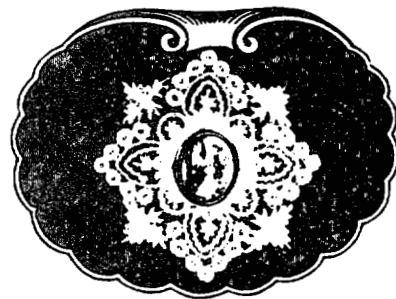
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
