NEW SOURCE FOR LOCATING
OLD FAMILIES IN TEXAS



In 1974 the Texas Department of Agriculture inaugurated the Family Land Heritage Program to register farms and ranches in Texas that have been owned and operated by the same families for a century or more. On the 14th of October of that year, 1200 such property owners and their relatives were honored on Family Land Heritage Day at the Texas State Fair in Dallas.

At the time of our nation's 200th anniversary, when Family Land Heritage Day was celebrated with appropriate ceremonies in the Hall of State at the Dallas Fairgrounds, the oldest such estate registered to that date was The Noriacitas Ranch in Jim Hogg County. It was established in 1740, some 36 years before the American Declaration of Independence (and 96 before the Texan Declaration), by Simon de Hinojosa [Simon Ynojosa in The Handbook of Texas] who had received around 25,000 acres as a land grant from the King of Spain. Today, the ranch is owned by Isidro G. Gutierrez Jr. and his sister Miss Idela Marta Gutierrez, who are 4-great-grandchildren of the founder.

The Department of Agriculture has annually published a very attractive, illustrated booklet, a Registry designed to record "information on families who have held the land for agricultural production for 100 years or more." The information (grouped under alphabetically arranged counties) includes name of farm or ranch, year of founding, location, name(s) of founder(s) and his/her place of origin, and current owners.

The historical/genealogical data varies from a few lines to several paragraphs, depending on the volubility of the interviewee, presumably. (Some of the Texas history is rather questionable, and the spelling of German place-names will necessitate a bit of research to identify them.) But even if it is all somewhat vague, the family traditions mentioned provide clues for descendants to follow up.

In a few instances, the original land grant has been added to manyfold over the years, but most present a sadder picture. When their ancestors had built up an estate of 12,000 acres, one wonders why the current owners have only 120. What a saga it would make if we could chronicle the circumstances of each loss of acreage! It is very likely that many poignant tales would be revealed: a crop failure due to a freak of nature, the trauma of seeking a loan, more disaster, a mortgage foreclosure or a tax sale perhaps. Or maybe the parents sold some of the land to send the children to college, or to pay for catastrophic hospital bills; or the old home-place was divided among ten children when the patriarch died, and most of them sold to strangers and moved to town. No doubt each diminution of their land brought heartache to someone.

Volume 1 of the registers includes a valuable Glossary of Terms pertaining to land ownership in Texas, and a review of land grant policy from the Spanish period until statehood in 1845/46.

Many touching old photographs of people (not named) and their homes enhance the realism of the book, but of even greater appeal (in this writer's opinion) are the exquisite line drawings that embellish the pages whenever there is space at the bottom. These include old barns and farmhouses, windmills, a rusty water pump, lanterns, miles of barbed-wire fence, distant mountains, cactus in the desert--things that convey the feeling of lonely isolation that our pioneer ancestors endured and often loved.

Just skimming these disconnected sketches of diverse families in a given county is an alluring peek at the history of that area.

Mrs. Robin Rader, Supervisor of Genealogy Services, has procured a set of the annual Registry volumes for the Genealogy Section of Texas State Library [GEN 976.4 / T3123f]. Since their indexes cover only the current owners of the land, it was thought that an alphabetical list (by county) of the founders and other deceased persons who are mentioned in the background histories would be of interest to many present-day researchers. [However, references to Sam Houston, Stephen F. Austin and other empresarios and heroes are too numerous to index.]

In the following list for Volume 1, maiden names are in parentheses when determinable (three dots if unknown); nicknames are in quotation marks; editorial suggestions in brackets. Sometimes it was hard to tell if a name was in a past generation or still living.

A tricky factor one must contend with in reading old letters and diaries is the inconsistent abbreviation of the word county. "Cty," "Cnty," or "Coty" in handwriting may look like "City," but a trip to Washington City [District of Columbia] for an early Texan took considerably longer than one to Washington Cty in southeast central Texas.

Or suppose a letter written in the 1850s reads "The Kilpatricks live here in Austin near us." A Kilpatrick researcher might run to the printed 1850 census of Travis County but find no Kilpatricks. (This is all hypothetical.) The fact is, people often referred to their county without using the word County. The letter should have been carefully examined for other clues to the location--Austin County is quite a distance southeast of Travis County.


Texas probably ranks first in the nation in having towns with the same (or nearly the same) name as their respective counties. Picking out county seats alone we find:

Andrews - Archer (City) - Bandera - Bastrop - Bee(ville) - Belton (Bell Co) - Brown(wood) - Burnet - Childress - Coleman - Comanche - Crane - Crosby(ton) - Dallas - Denton - Dickens - Eastland - El Paso - Floyd(ada) - Galveston - Goliad - Gonzales - Hamilton - Haskell - Hill(sboro) - Jack(sboro) - Jasper - Karnes (City) - Kaufman - Kerr(ville) - Lampasas - Liberty - Lipscomb - Llano - Lubbock - Madison(ville) - Mason - Menard - Midland - Montague - Nacogdoches - Newton - Orange - Palo Pinto - Refugio - Rockwall - San Augustine - San Saba - Sterling (City) - Throckmorton - Uvalde - Victoria - Wharton - Wheeler - Wichita (Falls) - Zapata.




DESCENDANTS OF NINIAN BEALL SOUGHT

TEXAS VOLUNTEER UNITS IN THE MEXICAN WAR 1846-48

Part 17

1st Regiment, Texas Foot Riflemen

(Microcopy #278, Roll # 6, made by National Archives, read at Texas State Library, Genealogy Section, by Podie Ligon, AGS member)

It is not clear why infantry units of the Texas volunteer companies in the Mexican War are inserted on the film between groups of cavalry. Enlistments were rather haphazard, as shown in Henry W. Barton's Texas Volunteers in the Mexican War, and six-month terms sometimes overlapped those for three months or for the duration of war.

Governor James Pinckney Henderson "chose to abandon his executive responsibility so that he could command the Texans in the field" (supra, p. 20). He hoped to recruit a whole division of Texans, which would call for "one major general--a requirement he was willing to fulfill" (ibid.), although he was too ill to mount his horse much of the time.

Albert Sidney Johnston was elected colonel of the First Regiment of Texas Foot Rifles at Fort Polk (Point Isabel, Texas) in mid-June 1846, and began training civilians to be soldiers. This was a wise choice, for Johnston "knew both his craft and the kind of men he had to deal with" (ibid.)

Company A of the 1st Regiment, Texas Foot Rifles, had been the first to join Gen. Zachary Taylor at his Point Isabel base after he requested reinforcements on the first of May. Two days later Charles A. Seefeld brought in 15 volunteers who, in their eagerness, had left Galveston before the quota of 50 privates had been filled. They were accepted for three months' service and awarded the coveted title, Company A. Captain Seefeld returned to Galveston to recruit the missing men, but was able to assemble only 20 by the 7th of July. "The original detachment served its entire term at Fort Polk...and was mustered out on August 4" (ibid., pp. 22-23).

Regimental officers elected to serve under Colonel Johnston were Ephraim W. McLean, lieutenant colonel; James M. Wells, major; William P. Ballinger, adjutant; Hanson Alsbury, quartermaster; William R. Smith, surgeon; Charles H. Wagner, assistant surgeon; William Jones, sergeant major.

At the end of July the regiment began its march from Fort Polk to Camargo, south of the Rio Grande in Tamaulipas, Mexico. They arrived on the 10th of August, the majority so disgruntled that they voted down a proposal to extend their term from three to the then required six months. According to Colonel Johnston's own records, 224 voted to stay and 318 to return home. The deciding influence is now thought to have been "Captain Buchel's Company H, which had suffered much illness and six deaths while detached from the regiment in the vicinity of Point Isabel." Thus the entire First Regiment of Texas Foot Riflemen were mustered out at Camargo late in August 1846. [But I can attest that that brief service entitled a veteran to 50 acres of bounty land--Editor.]

However, Captain Shivers organized a company composed of 35 from Company K (Mississippians?) and 26 from other companies who still


wanted to see some action. It was attached to the 3rd Brigade (regular infantry and artillery), in which it served during the Monterrey Campaign.

Captain Seefeld and 34 men from the former foot regiment plus 39 other men were accepted into Gen. John E. Wool's force then being assembled at San Antonio. The new company had to return to the mouth of the Rio Grande for transportation to Port Lavaca, whence they proceeded to march to San Antonio. The better part of the company (or "Those who survived illness and temptation to desert," as Barton expresses it) were with General Wool later at Buena Vista.

Unfortunately, this section of the microfilm has no interesting "Remarks," not even ages. Since most of the men were mustered out at Camargo, only exceptions in that column are shown on our transcript in the following pages and succeeding issues.

The companies of this regiment were recruited by their respective captains in the areas shown, mustered in on the dates given, and were assigned letters according to the following table:

Book Reviews

PASSPORTS OF SOUTHEASTERN PIONEERS 1770-1823, by Dorothy Williams Potter. Baltimore: Gateway Press, Inc., 1982. 7 x 10, hard-bound, printer's type, xi + 449 pp.; notes and references, bibliography, index, facsimile documents.

This handsome book not only reveals thousands of names of men who traveled through the southeastern parts of the United States in this crucial time period but also serves as a historical encyclopedia on that subject. A person who studies Dorothy Williams Potter's historical background material in the text and in the notes, who fully understands the reasons that these passports were issued, will have a good start on understanding migration patterns in America.

Passports of Southeastern Pioneers 1770-1823 covers three kinds of passports: I - Spanish (in Mississippi Valley 1770-97); British and Spanish (in West Florida 1770-1810)

II - War and State Departments: Indian Agencies (Creek, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Cherokee) and Territorial Agencies (Territory of the United States South of the River Ohio; the Territories of Mississippi, Louisiana, Orleans, Missouri, and Illinois)

III - State: Pennsylvania (1758-1774), North Carolina (1767-1803), Georgia (1785-1820), Tennessee (1796-1812), Kentucky (1797-1808)

I venture to say that many of us thought Georgia was the only state that had issued passports. It was a revelation to this reviewer to learn of all the others. But as a matter of fact, passports issued in Georgia far outnumber any other kind that have survived. It seems there were more Indian land areas in that state.

Compiling and indexing these hundreds of references to travelers (references besides the actual passports) was a tremendous service to genealogists who surely will appreciate Ms Potter's accomplishment presented in this volume.

For example, a family that had been "lost" between the time they sold land in North Carolina and the time they paid taxes in Davidson County, Tennessee, was found in a list of "Intruders in Indian Territory" in East Tennessee 1796-98, reported to be "residing in the Cherokee Country not natives of the land." Even the name of the creek they resided on is given.

Another benefit to the reader that may be derived from this book is practice in reading old script, and even Spanish. Many facsimile documents are interpreted in the text (arranged by dates) so you can check your own interpretation.

For pure fun, the reader can try to solve the puzzle of names written by a Spanish-French man, Pedro Foucher. Could John Clibelin be John Cleveland? Juan Mecolmeck = John McCormick? Empfil = Hemphill? John W. Caugham = John M'Caughan?

The book is set in two columns, with a running head to show what is on each page. This is an especially valuable finding aid in the appendix, for those pages are headed "Notes and References to Pages 6-10" and so on, making it easy to find the right note. The refer-

ences identify just about every man of any prominence in the pertinent area.

It is regrettable that this perfectly splendid book is marred by careless proofreading. Word divisions such as follow-ed and a-bout may be permissible in modern pulp magazines, but should not be allowed to cheapen scholarly books. Merely swift scanning revealed several instances of beginning a line with the word that ended the previous line [the...the], and such misspellings as negotiated, diminishing, salves [slaves], convience, intrustions, ofical, exectuive, dse-cription, enforece--and I don't mean that they occurred in verbatim transcriptions. They can't be blamed on old-time lack of education.

Two small flaws must be attributed to the author--her usage of "emigration to" [It's immigration to and emigration from.], and her failure to identify "Pittsburg" at the outset. Its first appearance being ambiguous [not definitely located in Pennsylvania], I proceeded to look in the U.S. Postal Guide and found Pitsburg in Ohio and Pittsburg in CA, IL, IN, KS, KY, MO, NH, OK & TX. Finally, the context indicated that all "Pittsburgs" seemed to refer to Pittsburgh Pennsylvania, though some of the ones without the h are on waterways and could have been the shipping point referred to.

But for her diligence in searching, her skill in finding pertinent data in unlikely places, Ms Potter deserves an honorary degree from her fellow researchers!

MARRIAGE BONDS AND CONSENTS 1831-1850, MERCER COUNTY, KENTUCKY compiled by the Genealogical Committee of the Harrodsburg Historical Society, Harrodsburg KY in 1983. [No mailing address or price furnished to this reviewer] 8½ x 11; i + 144 pp.; photocopied typing; two indexes.

Marriage Bonds and Consents 1831-1850, Mercer County, Kentucky also contains "a few heretofore unpublished ones for years 1794-1830" covering 2½ pages, which should be a boon to previously disappointed searchers.

Following the page setting forth the Contents and some unique abbreviations, the 1831-50 bonds and consents are arranged alphabetically by grooms' names. The entries include names, date, bonds-men, witnesses, consent (who gave), and any remarks or relationships shown on the record. There is a helpful space between entries.

Three pages show additional marriages found in Ministers' Returns, then comes a seven-page index of Surnames Other Than Brides and Grooms, and finally a 20-page Index of Brides' full names--unnecessarily full, as they typed out the surname for each. For example: Fauntleroy 4 times, Montgomery 10 times, Thompson 16 times. What a waste of time and space!

This book appears to be meticulously prepared and should delight Mercer County researchers.

SEBASTIAN COUNTY, ARKANSAS, ORIGINAL LAND GRANTS compiled by Sue Clark. Published in 1982 by Frontier Researchers, Box 2141, Fort Smith AR 72902. 8¼ x 11; ii + 23 pp.; \$5.

Alphabetically arranged names are followed by the year of the grant, then Section - Township - Range. The grid map of the county shows kinds of soils, named streams, and some other wavy lines that may be roads. The compiler consistently misspells asterisk, but the typing has a neat appearance.

This should be a valuable tool for researchers in Sebastian Co.

CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS, ORIGINAL LAND GRANTS compiled by Sue Clark. Published in 1982 by Frontier Researchers, Box 2141, Fort Smith AR 72902. 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ x 11; photocopied typing; iii + 27 pp.; state and county maps; \$5.

Using the same format as above, this book is enhanced by more maps, by Tax Lists for 1821 and 1829, and by lists of Territorial Officers 1821-36. The compiler even compared names on tax lists with land records and the 1830 Census to verify spellings, and included some interesting notes on the county's taxing policy.

This book is a must for searchers in early Crawford County.

The Maltese cross on the stone may be a Masonic symbol. The inscription reads: "John Baptist Burleson - Co. B - 17 Regt - Texas Inf - C S A - Jan 9 1839 - Nov 20 1903"

(A) FRANKS_GANN_HAGER. Jeremiah Franks (b. 1791 GA) married Mourning --- (b. 1793 NC). Jeremiah and brothers (Jacob, John, Joseph, Charles, Elisha & Elijah) lived in White and Warren counties, TN and Marion Co, AL. Who were their parents?

Jeremiah's son Oliver (b. 1818 TN) married Cynthia Gann (b. 1821 TN), dau of John Gann in Itawamba Co, MS in 1838; moved to Arkansas in 1850s and to Caldwell Co, TX in late 1800s. Their children: Nancy (m. James Hager son of Stephen Hager & Elizabeth ---), Isaac Lemuel, Mourning, John, Jeremiah, Henry, William D., Fanny, Rachel & Manerva. Who were parents of Stephen Hager? Was he related to Sterling Hager of Arkansas?

(B) ALLEN_BIRD_DAWSON_DERRICK_DICKEY_DUGGAN_FOX_KEELER_MAGEE_McMAHAN_SHRADER_STRICKLAND_WALKER. Adam Fox (b. ca 1760) settled in Sevier Co, TN in 1783. [Not Sevier Co until 1794] In 1872, his great-grandson James Mathias Fox (b. 1853) left the Smokies for the plains of Texas. Traveling by train from Knoxville, he caught a steamer from New Orleans to Galveston and made his way overland to Liberty Hill [Williamson Co], 40 miles northwest of Austin. In 1873, James celebrated his 20th birthday while returning from Wyoming where he, his cousin Simon Fox and five others had taken 1800 longhorns up the Chisholm Trail.

In 1878, James married Laura Magee (dau of James Magee & Edna Dawson) and settled in San Saba Co before moving to Caldwell Co in 1882. Laura died in 1924; James moved to Nueces Co where he died in 1946.

Seeking information on all descendants of this Adam Fox including surnames: Derrick, Dickey, Walker, McMahan, Keeler, Allen, Strickland, Bird, Shrader, Duggan and many others.--Dick D. Fox, Route 9 Box 355, Sour Lake TX 77659.

AUSTIN_GILLILAND_JOHNSON_MOORE_WILLIAMS. My great-great-great-grandmother Nancy (possibly Johnson) m/1 William Gilliland who died 1800 in Davidson Co, TN. In 1802 Nancy m/2 Thomas J. Williams and soon moved to Arkansas Territory. [Ed. note: In 1812 the present area of Arkansas became part of Missouri Territory; in 1819 Congress created Arkansas Territory which included Oklahoma, says Everton's Handy Book for Genealogists.] In 1821 the Thomas Williams family moved into Texas and "Stephen F. Austin spent a weekend in their home as he traveled to San Antonio to ask permission to take up his father's work of bringing settlers to Texas."

In 1850 Nancy was living in TravisCo with her dau Mary Diane and son-in-law Thomas Moore--any descendants still there? When & where did Nancy die? Would like to exchange information on Gillilands, Williamses and Moores.--Mrs. Charles Johnson, Rt. 3 Box 146, Port Lavaca TX 77979. [Editor's query: Have you seen article on Thomas Wil-

liams in The Handbook of Texas? It says Thomas J. Williams was 28 in 1835, thus born in 1807, and probably was son of Thomas Williams who came to Texas in 1821. Nancy must have been mother of Thomas J.]

I need more information on my great-grandparents, Franz & Minna (REINHARDT/REINARZ) GRAF and their relatives, who came here (names of ships unknown) from Germany. They all met in Bexar Co, TX. I collected this information from 1900 Census of Bexar Co, Naturalization Records in Bexar County Courthouse, etc. If you have some information about any of them, please write to Miss M. C. Forister, 2310-A Rebel Road, Austin TX 78704.

Nov 13, 1882 - Andreas RUDLOFF [b. June 22, 1856 in Villdorf(f), King of Prussia] and wife Tressa (GRAF, Franz's sister) [b. Feb 8, 1855] arrived in Galveston TX. Their small son died on the ship and was buried at sea. Their other children were born in Bexar Co near Cibolo. Family moved to Cross Plains, Callahan Co, TX in 1906.

Nov 15, 1882 - Johan GRAF (Franz's brother?) [b. 1860 in Prussia] arrived Galveston. Johan lived in Los Angeles CA in 1922; was killed by a run-away team of mules (in Clyde, Callahan Co?). Need details.

May 1, 1883 - Charles RUDLOFF (Andreas's brother?) [b. 1855-57 in Machterburg (?) Germany] with wife Wilhelmina [b. Jan 1852] arrived in New York City. Two of their four children were born in San Antonio: Frederick [b. April 1889] and Charles [b. Sep 23, 1893 and d. June 28, 1942 in San Antonio, ae. 48]. Widow's name was Dena, an adopted son was Werner, a niece was Mrs. Edgar Becker.

July 21, 1883 - Franz GRAF, a Catholic [b. May 24, 1853 in Hannover, Prussia] with wife Minna (Reinhardt/Reinarz), a Methodist [b. Oct 10, 1853 in Germany] with 5 children: Otto, Henry [b. Jan 18, 1879 in Sieldorf (?) near Koln/Cologne, Germany], Frank, Dora, & 3-month-old Pauline, arrived in Baltimore MD from Bremen on steamship Ohio. They went by train to Bexar Co, near Kirby, where they had 6 more children: Lizzie, Rosa [d. in 1887 at age of 8 months; place of burial unknown], Metha, Alvina, Frido and Willie.

June 16, 1884 - William REINHARDT (Minna's father?) [b. 1817 in Magdeburg, Prussia] arrived in Baltimore MD, but name not on passenger lists. I was told that Minna's parents landed in Galveston and her father was drowned--found in shallow water of Corpus Christi Bay. Wilhelmina REINHARDT, widow of William (Minna's parents?) was living at 509 Dallas Street in San Antonio in 1889-90. Need data on them.

March 23, 1891 - Jakob GRAF (Franz's brother?) [b. December 1847-49 in Machteburg, Prussia] with wife Barbara [b. November 1849 in Germany] with their daughters Agnes and Rosa reached New York.

June 14, 1893 - Herman GRAF [b. February 1871] and brother Albert [b. August 1872] (sons of Jakob) both born in Machteburg, Germany and single, arrived in New York. [The record in 1900 Census showed that they had arrived with parents & 2 sisters in 1891.]

Minna REINHARDT had sister who lived in California--who? Franz GRAF may have had sister Anna Martha GRAF who m. Arthur Hugo SCHNEIDER. Children: Anna Martha, Richard Paul, Hugo Franz Alvin [b. April 8, 1906 in Schertz, Bexar Co, TX].

MEMORIAL TO LUCIE (CLIFT) PRICE

Austin Genealogical Society mourns the loss of one of its charter members, Mrs. Pinckney Bryan Price. Since the founding of the Society, Lucie has been a devoted and enthusiastic member, although failing health prevented her from attending meetings of late.

Lucie was born in August 1900 in Oklahoma or Indian Territory, where her father (William Henry Clift) held a governmental position. Orphaned early in life, she was found living in the household of her grandfather (Superintendent of the Blind Institute) in Austin on the 1910 census of Travis County. Having been disappointed to find that she was born too late to be enumerated on the 1900 census, Lucie was delighted when her close friend Emma Gene Gentry obtained a copy of the 1910 entry for her recently.

Lucie Clift married Pinckney Bryan Price and had three children: Dr. Clift Price, William H. Price, and Nancy (named for her great-grandmother Nancy Ann Delilah Pipkin who married Henry Harrison Clift). Nancy is now Mrs. T. Hardie Bowman. Lucie was proud of her ten grandchildren and five great-grandsons, who are featured in the memoirs of their parents which she was compiling.

Lucie departed this life on the 9th of September 1983 in Austin.

In the 1970s Mrs. Price meticulously copied the marriage records of Travis County, comparing the recorded version with the original license whenever it was on file. The inclusion of an index of brides and the identification of officiants (ministers, judges, justices of the peace, etc.) added to the value of the volume as a splendid reference book, privately published in 1973 as Travis County, Texas, Marriage Records 1840-1882.

She contributed many valuable articles to AGS Quarterly, notably (March 1971) a transcript of burials made in Oakwood Cemetery (Austin) 1859-66, while Alexander Eanes was City Sexton. Mrs. Price was assisted in this project by Mrs. Herbert R. Gentry.

In 1972 Lucie furnished interesting material for our quarterly by abstracting the first 82 pages of the Republic of Texas Travis County Deed Book A, 1840. In 1973 (for March through September issues) she compiled fascinating records entitled "Proofs of Heirship in Travis County Deed Books."

Mrs. Price sometimes did research for other people, John Wesley Hardin being one of her favorite subjects. The family names she traced included Ballinger, Beasley, Bryan, Clift, Dunn, Hocker, Logan, McMurry, Moores, Norwood, Paxton, Pipkin, Price, Scanland, and Thomson.

Since some of her lines were found in Alabama, it is fitting that Austin Genealogical Society and other friends have designated a set of books about that state to be given to the Genealogy Section, Texas State Library, as a memorial to Lucie. (Contributions may be sent to the Society at Box 774, Austin TX 78767-0774).

Alabama Records by Kathleen Paul Jones and Pauline Jones Gandrud, in 245 volumes, is considered "the most important compilation of Alabama research data," so a complete set will be a tremendous gift, welcomed by innumerable researchers. It was the feeling of some members that such a gift would also serve to honor all charter members of the Society.
