TRAVIS COUNTY CEMETERY REGISTERS

Readers will recall from the two previous Quarterlies that the huge ongoing project the Society is currently engaged in is the cataloging of all public and private cemeteries and registering of the gravesites in Travis County. There are well over 300 cemeteries already located. Some of these have been previously cataloged in one way or another, but this is the first time an attempt has been made to cover all cemeteries in one comprehensive documentation. We will be printing the registers of each cemetery in the Quarterly as its data compilation is completed by the Committee. A RETURN

As your editor I'd like to mention the marvelous trip my wife, Ruth, our sons Bill and Jim, and I just made in early August to the little village of Nové Mêsto pod Smrkem (New Town under Spruce Mountain) in extreme northern Bohemia in the Czech Republic. This is the village (within 3 km of the now-Polish border) from which my grandparents Friedrich Köhler and Maria Lauer emigrated to Hallettsville, Lavaca County, Texas, in 1871.

My dad had told me Grandpa came from the Austrian Empire, supposedly from Wiener Neustadt, south of Vienna. Fine; I knew my paternal grandparents were German and Grandpa's naturalization papers showed he had renounced loyalty to the Austrian Emperor. However, genealogical spadework, some fortuitous genealogical spadework here in Austin revealed to me that it was, instead, this little



north Bohemian village, called (in German) Neustadt Tafel Fichte. Note the name similarity; also, Grandpa wasn't wrong—prior to WWI Bohemia was in the Austrian Empire. In 1988 I obtained some family information through the Czech Embassy confirming they had been born in Tafel Fichte. It was fairly specific and extensive but the country then was still communistic; I didn't even think of visiting. But in 1989 the Iron Curtain rusted away, and in time a visit began to seem at least somewhat possible.

Yet I'm not a bold explorer on my own and I put the thought aside. Meanwhile the Internet opened up; one night last winter when I was browsing the Czech Republic I opened a link to P.A.T.H. Finders, Intl. (www.pathfinders.cz) in Prague. They offered genealogical services on-site and, more, they offered conducted trips to specific localities in the CR, including transportation, driver and interpreter. This was what I wanted; something set up ahead of time, geared to my specific needs. We engaged their services.

Suffice it to say the trip was an outstanding success for my family and me. Prague is one (Continued)


of the largest and best-preserved relics of medieval-Gothic memorabilia still existing in Europe. We found Pathfinders to be owned and managed by Tom and Marie Zahn, an absolutely charming young couple. He is American and Marie is Czech, and they combine the absolute best in both nationalities. Tom had assembled ahead of time what additional information he could find; Marie drove us to Novè Mêsto, and guided and interpreted for us; we met with the current mayor, who furnished us town plats of the 1800's and opened the small museum for us. We located the sites of my grandparents' homes and toured the area, completely fulfilling my notion of a trip back in time. Novè Mêsto was founded in



1607 as a mining town but has mainly been the center of a large textile area, which helps explain some of my forefathers being identified in the records as "Weavers." The area is picturesque; yes, there are spruce trees on Smrkem, and we stayed overnight at a charming spa within 5 km of Novè Mêsto. We even toured the nearby Friedland Castle, right, owned for a time by the notorious Duke of Friedland, Gen. Albrecht Wallenstein, of Thirty Years' War infamy. His ducal holdings included the Novè Mêsto area.

What we found was and must be tempered by an understanding of history and location. Novè Mêsto is in what had been called the Sudetenland, that northern rim of the Czech lands historically populated by Germans. It became part of Czechoslovakia when that nation was founded in 1918. Hitler annexed it in 1938, a key step leading to WWII. In 1948 the Czechs, under Communist influence, expelled all ethnic Germans from the area, mostly into Germany. The vacated lands have now become populated by a mix of peoples who have no roots in the area and consequently little affinity for it.

These scars are still evident. Novè Mêsto was a thriving little town of over 4,000 people before WWII, but now seems in many ways like a western ghost town. We found the lot (minus



any house) where my grandfather lived, and also my grandmother's house in much disrepair (now housing a family of Gypsies; see left). The church where their families worshiped (built ca 1607) is very neglected; the graveyard had been destroyed sometime during the Communist regime (and why not; it probably only contained German burials). The priest with whom we visited serves a congregation of perhaps 50. No people with any German surnames like mine (Köhler, Lauer, Legler, Neuman, Fischer, etc) remain. These circumstances simply remind one that wounds of war heal slowly; perhaps in another generation or so the situation

will have normalized. One hopes so.


In any case I'm very glad we went; there is some sense of fulfillment involved. Prague and the Czech Republic have come a long way since 1989 and we really enjoyed our stay. To each reader possibly pondering a trip "back home", I recommend do it! I would add this: a.) don't go until you are quite sure of the exact locality or you'll chase ghosts and waste time; and b.) avail yourself if at all possible of the services of an on-site genealogist or interpreter or guide. Unless you go to Prague you probably won't find someone as excellent and as likeable as Tom and Marie Zahn. They are truly exceptional!

Book Reviews

THE GREATEST GENERATION by Tom Brokaw; Random House, Inc., New York, 1998; wwwatrandom.com, \$24.95; 412 pages, including name, subject, and place index of all but minor references.

Most people by now have heard of, read, or read a review of this highly interesting, possibly somewhat biased, book by now. I say "possibly biased" as the author gives a tremendous number of examples to prove his point, but necessarily has no scientific proof that (my) his parents' generation was the "greatest."


Why include this book in a genealogical publication? Because it does reflect the sociology of the times of the people who might be called the "baby boomers" of WW I: Those who lived through the "Great Depression" of 1929 - 30s, served or helped the war effort of WW II, and the "Korean Conflict," now rightly called a "War" and other "police Actions," saw their children go off to serve in Vietnam, and all this while upholding (at least in general) the morals and standards of their parents.

Another important reason is that so many people are listed in this book, from all over the country (although a larger number from the author's childhood state, South Dakota, and the midwest, which many people believe is the embodiment of those values). Although the author seems to feel that most of those listed (other than some actual "Famous Ones") are, or started out as, ordinary people; obviously, they are people of accomplishment, or they would not be the subjects of the biographical sketches.

While most people will not find their relatives or ancestors in this book, those who do will be very rewarded with the amount of material, and details of lives portrayed. This book reflects the flavor of the lives of the subject generation in ways not typically seen in novels -- without over-dramatization, the really heroic ways they had of coping with the many problems and crises presented to them. Franklin Delano Roosevelt is quoted at the start of one chapter, "This generation of Americans has a rendezvous with destiny." We did, indeed!

BY A LINE OF MARKED TREES—Abstracts of CURRITUCK COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA, DEED BOOKS [1], 1-3, Compiled and written by John A. Brayton, sponsored by The Order of First Families of North Carolina; printed by Cain Lithographers, Inc., Jackson MS; \$15 postpaid, obtainable from the author at 1503 Union Ave., Suite 220, Memphis TN 38104; 6"x9" blue cloth binding; 165 pp.; bibliography; name and location indices.

Mr. Brayton has been quite busy of late; we reviewed his most recent book (before this one) in the June Quarterly, and here we find another in his line of valuable publications.

By a Line---- is not a discourse but a compilation—in this case of abstracts of Currituck County, North Carolina deeds. Mr. Brayton's discussion is limited to a four-plus page Introduction. Here he highlights the scarcity of deed information on this county (including fragments of a work by the Chicago Historical Society, interestingly.) The introduction is valuable for its background information for anyone interested in Currituck County deeds as well as useful abbreviations and terminology. The abstracts themselves are taken from the various Deed Books in the County and are compiled by deed book. This might be problematical for researchers except for the fact that Mr. Brayton has helpfully included fairly detailed name and location indices so that page-flipping is minimized.

This volume includes Books 1 and 2 and most of Book 3 of the county deeds. Mr. Brayton's stated intention is to complete the project by printing the rest of Book 3 and the remaining Book 4 at an early date. With Mr. Brayton's capabilities this shouldn't be long.

The project is supported by the Order of First Families of North Carolina, and is dedicated to Mr. Brayton's great³ grandmother, Mary Granberry (Williams) Bright, who was born in Currituck County in 1813. The profession of genealogy is significantly enhanced by the efforts of people like Mr. Brayton and we thank him for his efforts in its behalf. The review copy of this book has been donated by the author to the Genealogy Collection, Texas State Library.

Elias McLaughlin Family - SUMMARY

Elias was born on 6 April 1811 in Carlisle, Pennsylvania, according to his tombstone. However, no documentation about him or any possible parents has been found in the Cumberland County records. Amelia Jane Wheatley was born in 1813, according to her tombstone and family lore says she was born in Wheeling, Ohio County, (West) Virginia.

Amelia and Elias were married in Wheeling, (West) Virginia on 12 September 1 834. It is interesting to note that when the marriage was recorded in the Family Bible, Elias' last name was spelled M-c-G-I-a-u-g-h-I-i-n. This spelling was also used when recording the birth of their first child, Wesley. After that, in the Bible and in all other references, the M-c-L-a-u-g-h-I-i-n spelling was used. Amelia and Elias had 6 sons, their birth dates were recorded in the Family Bible, their birth locations were found in U.S. Census data (family lore gives Chatham's birth town). Their children were: Wesley Wheatley (30 A ug 1835/Ohio), Charles Newton (6 Dec 1837/Pennsylvania), Alonzo Franklin (25 Aug 1840/Ohio), Chatham Ewing (15 Apr 1844/New Lisbon, Ohio), Elias R. (22 Aug 1849/Pennsylvania), John Johnson (25 Mar 1852/Illinois).

Elias was a tailor, but apparently not a poor one. In the winter of1853-54, the family moved to Texas. They came down the Mississippi River, from Beverly, Illinois, and then to Galveston, Texas and onto Belton, Texas. There he bought 335 acres of land for \$4,200. This was surely a sizable sum back in the 1850's. He also bought several lots in town. He was in business with Isaac Wheatley, but Isaac's relationship to Amelia is not yet known. Elias was a member of the Bell County Agricultural Club which was organized 20 November 1857.

About 1860, Amelia and Elias moved to Austin, Texas. They lived in a big house at 304 West 13th Street. This house was just 2 blocks west of the State Capitol building. This is the same house that Chatham and his wife Rowena Totten Terheun lived in and where all their children, except Guy, were born. When he died, Elias owned three houses in Austin.

Elias died in Austin, Texas on 29 August 1877, and was buried in Oakwood Cemetery. Amelia lived until July1893, and then was buried beside her husband.

The Children of Amelia Jane Wheatley & Elias McLaughlin

Wesley Wheatley McLaughlin - SUMMARY

Wesley was born 30 August 1835in Ohio. He was 18 when the family moved to Texas the winter of1853-54. He married Bettie Shaw in October 1858. They had four children: Ida May born in November/December 1859, Charles William born 1862/3, Louis C. born1867/8, and Irene A. born about March 1870. Wesley served in the Confederate Army for1 month and 16 days. He was a printer and with his brother, Chat, published a weekly newspaper, *The Texas* Capitol, from 1877to1881. It was Austin's first political newspaper. In addition to publishing the newspaper, they also did book and job printing at their shop on the south side of Pecan Street (6th Street) between Lavaca and Guadalupe. Wesley's wife, Bettie,ran a boarding house, probably renting rooms in their home. Their address was "Congress Avenue between Pine and Cedar Streets." (Pine Street is now 5th and Cedar Street is now 4th.) Wesley had tuberculosis and died in December 1888. Wesley and Chat were the only brothers who married and had children.

Charles "Charlie" Newton McLaughlin -SUMMARY

Charlie was born 6 December 1837in Pennsylvania. He was 16 when the family moved to Texas. He was a newspaper man and worked as a printer in Houston and New Orleans before the Civil War. He saw action in the war in Virginia and was captured and spent a few months in prison before he was released. After the war he returned to work as a printer, and moved around a great deal. He was living with Chat in Austin in 1872,1877,1879. He moved back to Austin to stay in 1894. His health was apparently poor and in 1900 he moved to the Union Printers Home in Colorado to be treated for tuberculosis. He died there 5 August 1 902.

Alonzo Franklin "Frank" McLaughlin - SUMMARY

Frank was born 25 August 1840in Ohio. He was 13 when the family moved to Texas. He served in the Confederate Army and was killed at the battle at Arkansas Post, Arkansas on 11 January 1863. He was 1 of 6 killed in this battle. A truce had been called, but a few either didn't get the word, or didn't believe it.

Chatham "Chat" Ewing McLaughlin -SUMMARY

Chat was born 15 April 1844in New Lisbon, Ohio. He was 9 when the family moved to Texas. He served 4 years in the Confederate Army, from the age of 17to 20. His job was to confiscate horses for the Army's use. After the war he became a newspaper man like his older brothers, Wesley and Charlie, and met his wife while he was working in Galveston, Texas. Chat and Rowena were married on his birthday in 1872, he was 28 years old, she was only 17 years old. They then moved to Austin to live with his parents. They had nine children, three girls and six boys: Chat liked to tell people that the had 3 and a half dozen children. He spent the rest of his career as a newspaper man and printer in Austin, Texas. With his brother, Wesley, he published a weekly newspaper, *The Texas Capitol*, from 1877to1881. It was Austin's first political newspaper. In addition to publishing the newspaper, they also did book and job printing at their shop on the south side of Pecan Street (6th Street) between Lavaca and Guadalupe.

Elias R. McLaughlin -SUMMARY

Elias R. was obviously named after his father, but there is no mention of what the R. stood for. He was born 22 August 1849 in Pennsylvania. He was only 4 when the family moved to Texas. He died in Austin on 13 September 1866, at the age of 17.

John Johnson McLaughlin -SUMMARY

John was born 25 March 1852 in Illinois. He was just a baby when the family moved to Texas in the winter of 1853-4. As an adult he drove a hack in all the larger cities of Texas. A hack was a wagon for hire. Fred McLaughlin wrote that he was a happy man, and a handsome one, but he was not the marrying kind. He died at the age of 39 of tuberculosis.






Expanded Plat---Top Left







Expanded Plat---Top Right




Expanded Plat---Middle Left




Expanded Plat---Middle Center




Expanded Plat---Middle Right



The Austin Genealogical Society GENERAL INFORMATION

PURPOSE: Austin Genealogical Society was organized in 1960 as a not-for-profit corporation chartered by the State of Texas. Its purposes are to collect and preserve genealogical and historical information about the people of Texas, particularly pertaining to the City of Austin and to Travis and surrounding counties; to instruct and assist members in genealogical research; and to publish public and private records of genealogical interest. In addition, the AGS supports the Genealogical Collection, Texas State Library by donations of books and other genealogical material. Gifts and bequests to AGS are tax-deductible to the full extent permitted by law.

MEMBERSHIP is open to all upon payment of annual dues. Classes: Individual: \$20; Family (two in the same household): \$30.00; Patron of AGS: \$100.00; Lifetime: \$500.00 (\$300 if over 65). All classes entitle one copy of each Quarterly and monthly Newsletter, as well as two pages apiece (a total of four pages for Family or higher whether one or two people submit listings) in the Ancestor Listing issue (June). **After 1 July**, dues are \$10.00 for the balance of the year, but you will only receive the publications produced after the date you join. Membership includes receipt of the annual Membership Handbook which is published each Spring.

DUES FOR EXISTING MEMBERS ARE PAYABLE on or before JANUARY FIRST of each year for the ensuing year. If dues are not received by 1 February, the name must be dropped from the mailing list. If membership is reinstated later and Quarterlies and Newsletters have to be mailed individually, postage must be charged. (Back Quarterlies are supplied only IF available--very few extras are printed). Send payment to AGS Treasurer, P.O. Box 1507, Austin TX 78767-1507.

MEETINGS of the general membership begin at 7:30 p.m. on the fourth Tuesday of each month except August and December. Members are encouraged to come as early as 6:30 to socialize with each other. MEETING PLACE: Highland Park Baptist Church, 5206 Balcones Dr.. Take Northland (FM 2222) exit off Loop 1 (Mopac). Go west one block to Balcones Dr, then left 1 ½ blks. The Church and parking lot are on right. VISITORS ARE ALWAYS WELCOME. The Board of Directors meets at 6:15 in a separate room.

BOOK REVIEW POLICY: Books on appropriate subjects related to genealogy will be reviewed, but CANNOT be reviewed in AGSQ on the basis of advertising alone. If a review copy is received by the Review Editor at 2202 W. 10th. St., Austin TX 78703 by the first of February, May, August or October, it will be reviewed in the next Quarterly, space permitting. It will then be placed in the Genealogy Collection, Texas State Library, available to all patrons.

CHECK RETURN POLICY: Members and other payees <u>must</u> pay AGS the cost of any returned check (currently \$5.00) over and above the charge their bank may impose.

AGS QUARTERLY is issued about the middle of March, June, September and November. Contributions are welcome, subject to editing for style/size. Contributor is completely responsible for accuracy and any copyright infringement. AGS assumes no responsibility for content of submitted material. See inside front cover for address.

ANCESTOR LISTING PAGES (June issue of Quarterly) must reach the Editor at 4500 Hyridge Drive, Austin TX 78759-8054 by the TENTH OF MAY. They must be BLACK and LEGIBLE, whether typed, hand-written, computer-printed or in superior calligraphy. Months must be SPELLED or abbreviated, not in figures. DATES SHOULD BE SHOWN in accepted genealogical style, that is, DAY, MONTH, YEAR (4 no;s.). Allow space for binding at inner margins of facing pages; I.e., your first page will be a left-hand page. Carefully check horizontal pages (reading in the 11-inch direction). Otherwise, the Editor has to position some pages upside down to prevent loss of data in the stapling-punching process. NO 81/2x14 sheets, please! You may submit Lineage or Family Group charts, Ahnentafels, narratives, cemetery inscriptions, Bible records, census data, queries, or a combination of material, just so it is not under copyright. BE SURE to proofread your material for accuracy and clarity so we will not publish faulty or incorrect data. Put name and address of submitter on each page in legible form (not blind embossed). Consult a recent June Quarterly for suggestions. Remember that reproductions are dimmer than originals so try to provide good quality originals.

REMEMBER: Individual membership secures two facing pages.

Family or higher membership allows you four pages.

DEADLINES for everything in the Quarterly except book reviews: 10th of February, May, August and October. Material sent addressed only to AGS Box Number may not reach Editor in time.
